

Word of Life

3rd Sunday of Easter: If You Love, Work

"When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs." (Jn 21: 15).

St. Peter had denied Christ three times on the terrible night of Holy Thursday to Good Friday. After the Resurrection, Peter had regained his faith, but a rectification of that triple offense was pending. The Lord wanted to wash away his stain with a triple question that allowed the disciple, called to become the Vicar of Christ, to testify before the rest of the apostles to his love for the Master, which had been questioned. But, in addition to Peter, Christ wanted to teach the others a lesson at the same time. That is why He didn't only ask Peter if he loved Him, but, after each response of His Vicar on earth, the Lord entrusted him with the task of taking care of the flock that was to follow him, in the present and in the future. "If you love me," Christ wanted to say to Peter "show me by working for me and for my cause."

It is the same that He says to each one of us: if you love me, work, work for me; if you love me, evangelize and do apostolic work; if you love me, help those who are suffering, because all that you have done for these least of my brothers, you have done for me.

The lesson that Christ gives us through that triple inquiry to Peter is that love is not only a feeling. It cannot be reduced to sentiment. Love without works is only a caricature of love and is even offensive. You cannot tell someone that you love him and, at the same time, not help him or worse yet hurt him. As we say in Castilian Spanish: works are loves and not good intentions. This is what Christ taught us.

Resolution: Do God's will in your life, as an expression of the love that you feel for Him. Do the same with your neighbor as well. Show him your love through good works.

From the Pastor's Desk



Del Escritorio del Párroco

My dear parishioners,

When we go to see the doctor, or if we are taking a flight, our main concern is that the doctor gives us the right diagnosis and medication, and that the pilot knows how to fly an airplane. We do not put ourselves in the hands of a physician and go through a heart surgery just because we were great friends in High School, but because we know he has the knowledge and experience to operate the heart. If in addition, we are great friends, that's just that, a plus. We are not really concerned if the pilot of our flight to Europe is addicted to gambling, but that he takes us safe and sound to Europe, not to Australia. We say that a physician or a pilot are good, if they fulfill their tasks well. If the contrary, we say they are not.

Some media have spoken of the first Asian or African Pope, as if being of this or that race, or from this or that country was the non-negotiable principle for the unity and mission of the Church. In our modern world, it seems that it is more important to break a paradigm than to be truly capable of performing certain duties. It is true that the tendency for several decades was to have Italian Popes until we had a Polish one, then a German, and then an Argentinian Pope. The Church was greatly blessed to have Saint John Paul II, but she was not blessed just for the fact that he was from Poland, but that he truly worked hard to firmly fulfil his mission as the Vicar of Christ and Successor of St. Peter, that of bringing about unity in the Church by shedding light in the matters of faith, morals, and customs with the heart of a compassionate Pastor. The rest - his origin, culture, and personal background - are a plus, an accumulation of experiences at the service of and not above the mission of tending the sheep entrusted by God.

The Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church states the mission of the Pope is to be the perpetual, visible source and foundation of the unity of the Church (n. 182). We pray that the cardinals may be docile to the action of the Holy Spirit, so that they may choose he who is able and called by God to fulfill this mission, so that through his guidance, and in the light of the truth and charity, we may become one in mind and heart, and publicly confess with pure lips that Jesus Christ is Lord for the glory of God the Father.

Mis queridos feligreses,

Cuando vamos al médico, o si tomamos un avión, nuestra principal preocupación es que el médico nos dé el diagnóstico y la medicación correctos, y que el piloto sepa pilotear un avión. No nos ponemos en manos de un médico para que nos opere a corazón abierto sólo porque éramos grandes amigos en la preparatoria, sino porque sabemos que tiene el conocimiento y la experiencia para llevar a cabo dicha operación. Si además, somos grandes amigos, eso es sólo eso, un plus. En realidad, no nos preocupa si el piloto de nuestro vuelo para Europa es adicto al juego, sino que nos lleve sanos y salvos a Europa, no a Australia. Decimos que un médico o un piloto son buenos, si cumplen bien su función. Por el contrario, decimos que no lo son.

Algunos medios de comunicación han hablado del primer Papa asiático o africano, como si ser de esta raza o de esta otra, de este país o de este otro fuera el principio no negociable para la unidad y la misión de la Iglesia. En nuestro mundo moderno, parece que es más importante romper un paradigma que estar verdaderamente capacitado para llevar a cabo determinadas obligaciones. Es cierto que la tendencia durante varias décadas fue tener Papas italianos hasta que tuvimos un Papa polaco, luego uno alemán y después uno argentino. La Iglesia fue muy bendecida al tener a San Juan Pablo II, pero no fue bendecida sólo por el hecho de que fuera polaco, sino porque realmente trabajó con firmeza para cumplir con la misión, como Vicario de Cristo y Sucesor de San Pedro, de lograr la unidad de la Iglesia arrojando luz en las cuestiones de fe, moral y costumbres con el corazón de un pastor compasivo. Lo demás -su origen, cultura e historia personal- es un plus, un cúmulo de experiencias al servicio y no por encima de la misión encomendada por Dios de apacentar a Su rebaño.

El Compendio del Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica afirma que la misión del Papa es ser el perpetuo y visible principio y fundamento de la unidad de la Iglesia (n. 182). Rezamos para que los cardenales sean dóciles a la acción del Espíritu Santo, a fin de que elijan a quien es capaz y está llamado por Dios a cumplir esta misión, para que por su guía, y a la luz de la verdad y la caridad, lleguemos a tener una sola mente y un solo corazón, y confesemos con labios puros que Jesucristo es Señor para gloria de Dios Padre.
