

Word of Life

4th Sunday of Easter: A Good Vassal of Such a Good Lord

"My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish. No one can take them out of my hand." (Jn 10: 27-28).

Normally, men consider that God is close to them, that He loves them, when He hears their voice, when He heeds their pleas. For most, the miracle is the validation, the proof of God's love. This is the reason why crises of faith arise -from poorly formed faith, certainly- when God does not apparently hear our supplications. However, we should be consistent with our own criteria and apply them to our relationship with God. If we did so, we would ask ourselves: Am I listening to the voice of God? Am I being attentive to the cries for help that God hurls at me from His pain, from His need? Am I not giving Him more than enough reasons to believe that I do not love Him? Because, if God's plans sometimes escape our intelligence, the same does not happen with God; that is to say, God does not ask us for things that we cannot do, He only asks us for the help that we can give Him.

God is a good Lord and has the right to find good vassals, good servants, good friends, and good disciples. He has given up His life for His sheep, for us. What else could He do? Could there be a greater manifestation of love? Could a more beneficial miracle be performed for the human race than saving it from its sins and opening the gates of everlasting life? That is why He has the right to find a comparable response in us. We must listen to His voice and follow Him, because only if we do so will he complete in us the work that He has already begun; only then will He give us the promised eternal life. We must be the sheep that such a good shepherd has the right to find.

Resolution: Fine-tune your conscience, not allowing it to become muddy because of the voices of this world. Listen to the pleas that God is uttering from the Tabernacle or from your neighbor in need, and attend to them.

From the Pastor's Desk



Del Escritorio del Párroco

My dear parishioners,

Let's go back to our reflections on Sacramentals. The sacramentals are sacred signs which bear a resemblance to the sacraments. They signify effects, particularly of a spiritual nature, which are obtained through the intercession of the Church. By them men are disposed to receive the chief effect of the sacraments, and various occasions in life are rendered holy. (CCC 1677)

The clerical vestments -such as the stole, the chasuble, the dalmatic, the miter, the crosier, etc.- worn by the clergy are sacramentals. They have risen to the dignity of a sacramental recognized by the Church, because they orient the faithful to the sacraments these clerics celebrate. God prescribed Old Testament priests very exacting and highly ornate specifications for their attire. The Catholic understanding of the vestments of the ministerial priesthood (Presbyters & Bishops) is rooted in God's will, revealed in the Old Testament. "For the glorious adornment of your brother Aaron you shall have sacred vestments made. Therefore, tell the various artisans whom I have endowed with skill to make vestments for Aaron to consecrate him as my priest." (Ex 28:2-3). When a priest is carrying out his ministerial duties, he is acting in the person of Christ, the high priest of the New Law, robed in goodness and clothed in charity. And if Aaron and his Old Covenant priests wore ornate garments befitting their sacred sacrificial duties, how much more should the New Covenant priests, who sacramentally re-present Christ's one Sacrifice of Calvary? While these vestments might appear grandiose because of their design and the fine material used, the intent is to highlight the holiness and responsibilities unique to the office, not to idolize the individual person. They are set apart and blessed by the Church to sanctify the thoughts, intentions, and devotional labors of those who use them, and of those who benefit from the sacred services. They should be treated with the utmost care, since they visually illustrate the sacredness of the holy office received at ordination (1). Depending on whether it is a Deacon, a Priest or a Bishop, these clerical vestments will differ in their appearance and design to visually indicate who they are.

As the clergy wear these sacred vestments for the celebration of the sacraments, their hearts should be clothed with humility and purity of intention, otherwise they would imitate the hypocrisy of the pharisees, whose boastfulness and self-centeredness were hidden in their fine and lavish garments.

Mis queridos feligreses,

Volvamos a nuestras reflexiones sobre los Sacramentales. Los sacramentales son signos sagrados con los que, imitando de alguna manera a los sacramentos, se expresan efectos, sobre todo espirituales, obtenidos por la intercesión de la Iglesia. Por ellos, los hombres se disponen a recibir el efecto principal de los sacramentos y se santifican las diversas circunstancias de la vida (CIC 1677)

Las vestiduras litúrgicas -como la estola, la casulla, la dalmática, la mitra, el báculo, etc.- que lleva el clero son sacramentales. La Iglesia las ha elevado a la dignidad de sacramental porque orientan a los fieles hacia los sacramentos que estos clérigos celebran. Dios prescribió a los sacerdotes del Antiguo Testamento especificaciones muy exigentes y ornamentadas para sus vestiduras sagradas. La comprensión católica de las vestiduras del sacerdocio ministerial (de presbíteros y obispos) tiene sus raíces en la voluntad de Dios, revelada en el Antiguo Testamento. «Harás ornamentos sagrados, dignos y decorosos, para tu hermano Aarón. Habla tú mismo con todos los artesanos a quienes he dotado de habilidad para que confecionen los ornamentos de Aarón, a fin de consagrarte sacerdote mío». (Ex 28:2-3). Cuando un sacerdote desempeña sus funciones ministeriales, actúa en la persona de Cristo, el Sumo Sacerdote de la Nueva Ley, revestido de bondad y caridad. Y si Aarón y los sacerdotes de la Antigua Alianza llevaban vestiduras ornamentadas acordes con sus sagradas obligaciones sacrificiales, ¿cuánto más los sacerdotes de la Nueva Alianza, que representan sacramentalmente el único Sacrificio de Cristo en el Calvario? Aunque estas vestiduras puedan parecer grandiosas debido a su diseño y al fino material utilizado, la intención es resaltar la santidad y las responsabilidades únicas del sagrado oficio del sacerdote, no idolatrar su persona. La Iglesia los bendice para santificar los pensamientos, las intenciones y los trabajos de quienes los usan, y también de quienes se benefician de las celebraciones litúrgicas. Deben tratarse con sumo cuidado, ya que ilustran visualmente la sacralidad del santo oficio recibido en la ordenación sacerdotal (1). Dependiendo de si se trata de un Diácono, un Sacerdote o un Obispo, estas vestiduras clericales diferirán en su apariencia y diseño para indicar visualmente a quién representan.

Mientras el clero usa estas vestiduras sagradas para la celebración de los sacramentos, sus corazones deben estar revestidos de humildad y pureza de sus intenciones, de lo contrario imitarían la hipocresía de los fariseos, cuya jactancia y egocentrismo se ocultaban en sus finas y fastuosas vestiduras.
