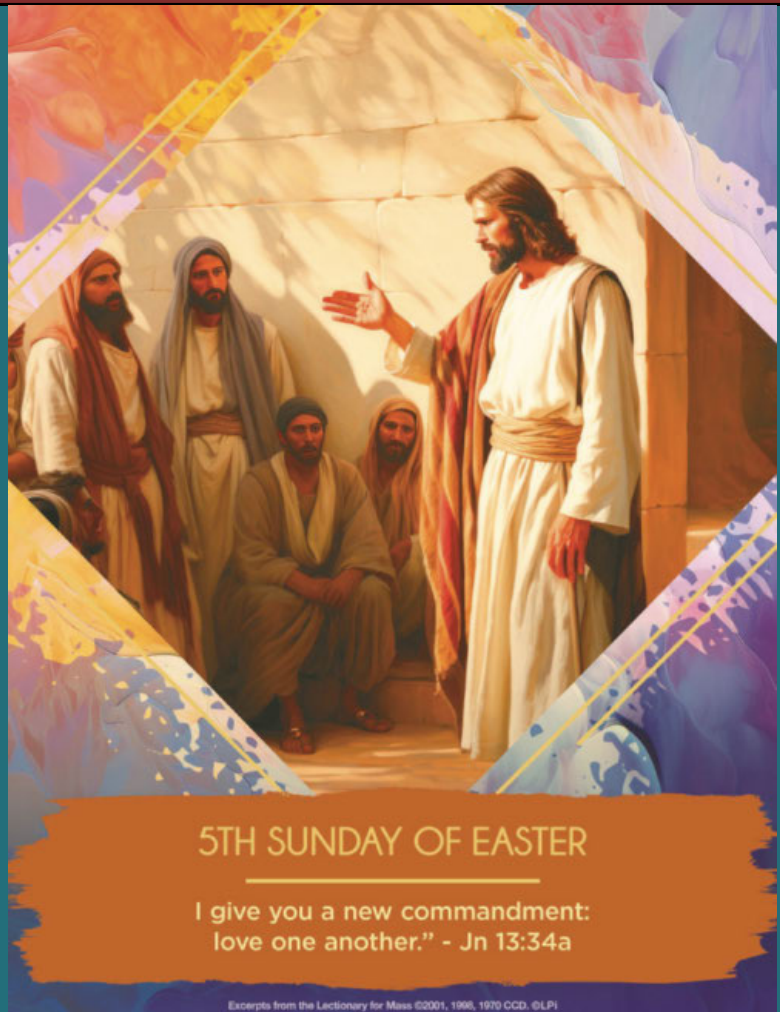

Word of Life

5th Sunday of Easter: Love as He Loves

"My children, I will be with you only a little while longer... I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (Jn 13: 33-35).

Love is a law impressed in the heart of every person, one way or the other. Even the most heinous of criminals loves or has loved someone. He loves his own, those of his blood, the members of his gang or group of murderous colleagues. Therefore, what Jesus Christ does is not simply invite us to love because there would not be much novelty in that. He does not speak of just love, but of "His love".

This "to love as Christ loves" is what is distinctive and typical of the Christian. Only the Christian has it because he makes Christ his reference point, his model to imitate. But in order to love as Christ loved implies fulfilling a series of requirements, the same ones that the Lord carried out. For example, it is essential to forgive enemies and that, we know well, is very difficult. It is also mandatory to be willing to go even to the limit of giving one's life for the loved one, just as Christ did for us, and that is also very difficult. Another characteristic of Christian love is that it must embrace everyone and not just those who belong to the family, the group, or those deserving of our sympathy. To love like Christ should lead us "to love first", not waiting until the other takes the initiative. Similarly, He invites us to seek a love that is reciprocal so that our neighbor does not tire of always giving without receiving anything in return.

All this is very difficult and, in a certain way, is far beyond human strength. That is why we must be united to Christ in order to love like Christ because without Him we can do nothing.

Resolution: Love everyone. Be the first to love. Be willing to start over again by forgiving or asking for forgiveness. Do not weary your neighbor with your selfishness and, above all, pray.

From the Pastor's Desk



My dear parishioners,

We have a new Pope! We rejoice and give thanks to God for Leo XIV, the 267th Successor of St. Peter, and the first American Pope, but one with a Universal Heart, which is a result of his missionary wanderings, especially in Peru, where he spent over 20 years. We continue to pray that he fulfills this, his new and delicate mission: that of confirming his brethren in the Faith amidst a world in continuous turmoil and confusion. Being aware of this, he said in his first homily before the cardinals that "God has called me by your election to succeed the Prince of the Apostles, and has entrusted this treasure to me so that, with his help, I may be its faithful administrator for the sake of the entire mystical Body of the Church. He has done so in order that she may be ever more fully a city set on a hill, an ark of salvation sailing through the waters of history and a beacon that illumines the dark nights of this world. And this, not so much through the magnificence of her structures or the grandeur of her buildings — like the monuments among which we find ourselves — but rather through the holiness of her members. For we are the people whom God has chosen as his own, so that we may declare the wonderful deeds of him who called us out of darkness into his marvelous light."

From my point of view, his first words at the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica reveal the main priority in his Pontificate: peace. "Peace be with you all! Dear brothers and sisters, these are the first words spoken by the risen Christ, the Good Shepherd who laid down His life for God's flock. I would like this greeting of peace to resound in your hearts, in your families, among all people, wherever they may be, in every nation and throughout the world. Peace be with you! It is the peace of the risen Christ. A peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering. A peace that comes from God, the God who loves us all, unconditionally," he said.

May the roars of Pope Leo XIV re-ignite the fire that the Son of God brought to this world and wanted for His Church, that all may be consumed by His love and the only truth that saves us. May the Lion of the Tribe of Judah shake the hearts and consciences of all peoples through the voice of His Vicar on earth, to restore peace in our hearts, in the Church, and our world.

Mis queridos feligreses,

¡Tenemos Papa! Nos alegramos y damos gracias a Dios por León XIV, 267º Sucesor de San Pedro, y primer Papa americano, pero con un Corazón Universal, fruto de sus andaduras misioneras, especialmente en Perú, donde trabajó más de 20 años. Seguimos rezando para que cumpla esta su nueva y delicada misión: la de confirmar a sus hermanos en la Fe en medio de un mundo en continua agitación y confusión. Consciente de ello, dijo en su primera homilía ante los cardenales que "Dios, de forma particular, al llamarme a través del voto de ustedes a suceder al primero de los Apóstoles, me confía este tesoro a mí, para que, con su ayuda, sea su fiel administrador en favor de todo el Cuerpo místico de la Iglesia; de modo que esta sea cada vez más la ciudad puesta sobre el monte, arca de salvación que navega a través de las mareas de la historia, faro que ilumina las noches del mundo. Y esto no tanto gracias a la magnificencia de sus estructuras y a la grandiosidad de sus construcciones — como los monumentos en los que nos encontramos —, sino por la santidad de sus miembros, de ese pueblo adquirido para anunciar las maravillas de aquel que los llamó de las tinieblas a su admirable luz".

Desde mi punto de vista, sus primeras palabras en el balcón de la Basílica de San Pedro revelan la principal prioridad de su Pontificado: la paz. "Queridos hermanos y hermanas, éste es el primer saludo de Cristo resucitado, y Buen Pastor, que ha dado la vida por el rebaño de Dios. También quisiera que este saludo de paz llegue a sus corazones, alcance a sus familias, a todas las personas, donde quiera que se encuentren, a todos los pueblos, a toda la tierra. La paz esté con ustedes. Esta es la paz de Cristo Resucitado, una paz desarmada y una paz desarmante, humilde y perseverante, que proviene de Dios, de Dios que nos ama a todos incondicionalmente." – Dijo el Sumo Pontífice.

Que los rugidos del Papa León XIV vuelvan a encender el fuego que el Hijo de Dios trajo a este mundo y quiere para Su Iglesia, para que todos sean consumidos por Su amor y la única verdad que nos salva. EASTER SEASON

On the Third week of Easter we talk about the gestures that the priest makes at our Baptism. These gestures include: "The Imposition of Hands" where the priest extends his hands over the baptismal water and calls the Holy Spirit to consecrate the water; "The Sign of the Cross" which the priest makes with his finger over the forehead and chest to welcome the person into the Christian Church, "The Pouring of Water" when the priest slowly pours water three times over the head of the person while saying, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit," and "The Solemn Blessing," given to all the people present as a sign that Baptism is a shield of protection against evil and a blessing for us all. Baptism is a gift from our loving God. Let us celebrate this day as our Birth in God. We are children of the light and children of God.

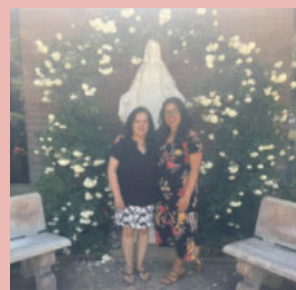
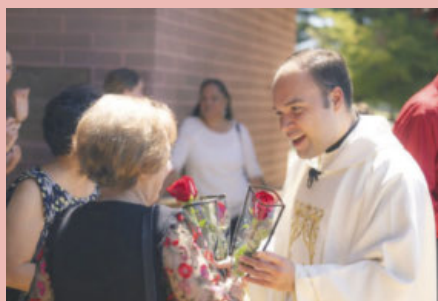

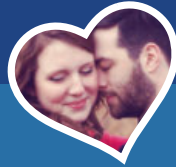
