Word of Life

7th Sunday of Easter (The Ascension of the Lord): Witnesses of Love

“And he said to them, “Thus it is written that the Messiah would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things.” (Lk 24: 46-48)

The liturgical celebration of the Ascension of the Lord into heaven each year presents to us the occasion to remember that we have reached adulthood. Jesus went about the world doing good. He did His part and did it well. But, He neither can nor wants to do it only through miracles. He wants us to contribute to the building of the Kingdom of Peace and Justice that He came to establish. Somehow, He needs us. He needs us to become “witnesses of His love”, witnesses of His in the midst of the world. He wants us to behave as adults and become His living extension on earth so that He may continue His work. To feel like this, to try living as His witnesses, is the objective of the “word of life” for this week.

In order to do so and in the face of any issue, we will have to ask ourselves: What would Jesus do? What should I do so as not to make His name look bad, since everyone knows that I am a Christian?

There will be moments in which we will have to remain silent and restrain our temper, our urge to scream. On the contrary, on other occasions, we will have to speak out to defend those who are being oppressed or so as not to hide our faith. At times, we will have to abandon some activities, even apostolic ones, to attend more to our family, while sometimes we will have to undertake more responsibilities to serve our neighbor or the Church. But we will always, always, have to love, so that, when those around us see us, they will say: “There is a Christian, a “living Christ”, a true follower of Christ.”

Resolution: Consider what Christ would do if He were in your place, and act in such a way as to make the name of Christ stand out, the name of Christian.

Palabra de Vida

7mo Domingo de Pascua — La Ascensión del Señor: Testigos del Amor

"Dijo Jesús a sus discípulos: ‘Así estaba escrito: el mesías padecerá, resucitará de entre los muertos al tercer día y en su nombre se predicará la conversión y el perdón de los pecados a todos los pueblos, comenzando por Jerusalén. Y vosotros sois testigos de esto’". (Lc 24, 46-48)

La celebración litúrgica de la Ascensión del Señor a los cielos nos plantea, cada año, la ocasión para recordar que hemos llegado a la mayoría de edad. Jesús pasó por el mundo haciendo el bien. Hizo su parte y la hizo perfectamente. Pero Él ni puede ni quiere hacerlo todo a base de milagros suyos. Desea que nosotros colaboremos con Él en la construcción del Reino de paz y de justicia que Él vino a instaurar. De alguna manera, nos necesita. Necesita que seamos “testigos de su amor”, testigos suyos en medio del mundo. Necesita que nos comportemos como adultos y que seamos su prolongación viva en la tierra para llevar adelante su obra. Sentirnos así, intentar vivir así, como testigos suyos, es el objetivo de la “palabra de vida” de esta semana.

Para hacerlo, tendremos que preguntarnos ante cada circunstancia: ¿cómo haría Cristo? ¿qué debo hacer para no dejar en mal lugar su nombre, pues todos saben que soy cristiano?

Habrán momentos en que tendremos que callar y contener nuestro carácter, nuestras ganas de gritar. En otras ocasiones, por el contrario, deberemos hablar para no ocultar nuestra fe o para defender a los que están siendo oprimidos. A veces tendremos que dejar actividades, incluso apostólicas, para ocuparnos más de nuestra familia, mientras que en otras tendremos que asumir responsabilidades al servicio del prójimo o de la Iglesia. Pero siempre, siempre, tendremos que amar, de tal modo que, al vernos, los que nos rodean digan: “Ahí va un cristiano, un “Cristo vivo”, un verdadero seguidor de Cristo”.

Propósito: Plantearme en cada ocasión qué haría Cristo si estuviera en mi lugar y obrar de tal modo que deje bien alto el nombre de Cristo, el nombre de “cristiano”.
