<u>Video Overview</u>: After the Last Supper, Jesus goes to the Garden to pray and prepare for what lies ahead. He knows he will be facing incredible suffering, when he prays to the Father if He could pass on drinking the "cup". In these moments, we see Jesus, the man who is both fearful and anxious, even to the point of sweating blood. Yet, he unites his human will—which dreads the coming events—with his Father's and is able to not just passively acquiesce to his Passion but embrace it. He doesn't deny his pain but unites it to the Father in an act of perfect sacrificial love. The lesson is clear that we are all called to do the Father's will, even when it is difficult. Because love involves sacrifice - dying to self and making sacrifices for the one we love. Indeed, love demands that we sometimes do things we don't want to do to serve the good of others as Jesus did.

Featured Study: The History of Salvation: God's Plan for His People by Msgr. Dan Deutsch

Topics of Interest: As Christ enters the holy city of Jerusalem to the acclaim of the people, 21st century Christians know that it quickly turned into accusations with a deadly intent. The palm celebration foretold the final vindication and victory of the Messiah in his Resurrection. This serves as a salutary reminder that each Sacrament, each mystery of the Church, contains within it the whole of the mystery of Christ. Our whole sacramental spirituality as Catholics combines the dark tones of the Passion as well as the bright ones of the Resurrection. Each Eucharist, because it includes the whole mystery of Christ, includes both movements: sorrow and joy. We begin the Mass with the Penitential Rite and end with the Communion Rite. The Eucharistic meal includes both the Passover Seder Supper of Holy Thursday and the sacrifice of Calvary on Good Friday. The Lord we truly receive in Holy Communion is the Risen Lord of Glory who is present in the consecrated host-body, blood, soul, and divinity. Because the Palm Sunday Liturgy includes both the foretaste of Christ's glory in the procession of the palms and the bitter agony leading up to the sacrifice of Calvary, it's a good time to reflect upon the nature of the Eucharist as the whole of the mystery of Christ.





# PASCHAL TRIDUUM





The Easter Triduum—which begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, reaching its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closed with Evening Prayer on Easter Sunday, is the summit of the Liturgical Year. It commemorates Christ's Paschal Mystery, i.e., the passion, death and resurrection

#### The Pontifical Good Friday Collection 2020 Postponed

The Congregation for the Eastern Churches has postponed this collection. In a communication from the Holy See dated March 27, 2020, it states: "The current COVID-19 pandemic concerns many countries and in many of them preventative measures preclude the normal community celebration of Holy Week."

With the approval of Pope Francis, the Collection for the Holy Land will take place on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>September 13</u>, <u>2020</u>, near the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

Although this collection is now postponed, you are asked to keep all Christians in the Holy Land in your prayers during the blessed days of Holy Week.

# The Triduum The Essence of Our Faith

#### **HOLY THURSDAY**

The Triduum is the whole of our faith in three days—the Paschal Mystery in its essence. It begins with Jesus' gift of himself in the Eucharist and includes his command that we serve others as he has served, that is, with his whole life, even in the grittiest dimensions of human life.

**Prayer intentions for the day:** vocations, service to the poor, faith in the unseen presence of God in the Eucharist and all the sacraments.

#### GOOD FRIDAY

The Passion encompasses every kind of suffering—physical, psychological, shame, humiliation, mockery and more—including death. In Jesus' case, it made no sense cosmically for a totally innocent man to become a scapegoat for us and endure the unmerited suffering as an archetype for all our suffering.

**Prayer intentions for the day:** victims of violence, bullying, scapegoating, those suffering physical and mental illness.

#### HOLY SATURDAY AND EASTER VIGIL

At the end of the normal course of human life, that is, death, all seemed to be lost. And from a strictly human, earthly perspective it was. The resurrection came out of the blue, just as creation itself did in the first place. Unexpected, beyond our imagining, the resurrection of Jesus makes it possible for us to hope for enternal life.]

**Prayer intentions for the day:** hope in what appears a hopeless situation, gratitude for the gift of life, trust in God's mercy.


