**Video Overview:** All of us have been lost at some point in our lives. The Apostles were feeling lost, because Jesus had just told them he was going to leave them in order to be crucified and die. Thomas said what was in all their hearts: “We do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?” Jesus’s answer might have been confusing when He said that he was the way, the truth, and the life. We can understand the meaning of his words only when we realize that he was saying that he was going to the Father. If we want to go to the Father, we must go through the Son, within the power of the Holy Spirit. We know Jesus, and in knowing him, we come to the Father. We have never been physically in the company of Jesus, so how can we get to know him? The answer is simple: through the Holy Mass, by receiving Christ in the Sacraments of the Church, by studying the Holy Scriptures, participating in the church, and through our prayers and devotions. When we do those things, we come to know Jesus and the will of God. Then we can truly confess that he is our way, our truth, and our life.

**Featured Study:** View ECHO Part I: The Creed Series; episode 10: The Church. The Church was founded by Christ to be the visible Kingdom of God on earth, and to bring about the unity of all humanity in Christ and through the Holy Spirit.

**Topics of Interest:** Jesus tells the apostles that he’s going to prepare a place for them “in my Father’s house.” They discover Jesus is leaving to go to the Father, but he assures his disciples that this absence is only so that he may prepare a place for them. He promises, “I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way.” He comes to us to dwell with us in time, in the flesh, and in so doing, wins us the ability to dwell with him in eternity. Unless Jesus was God, he couldn’t save us from sin. He couldn’t gain us entry to Heaven and he couldn’t give us his flesh to eat. This is what Jesus reveals in the second part of this passage. “I am in the Father and the Father is in me,” Jesus says in language that seems to stretch to the breaking point in trying to convey these divine truths.

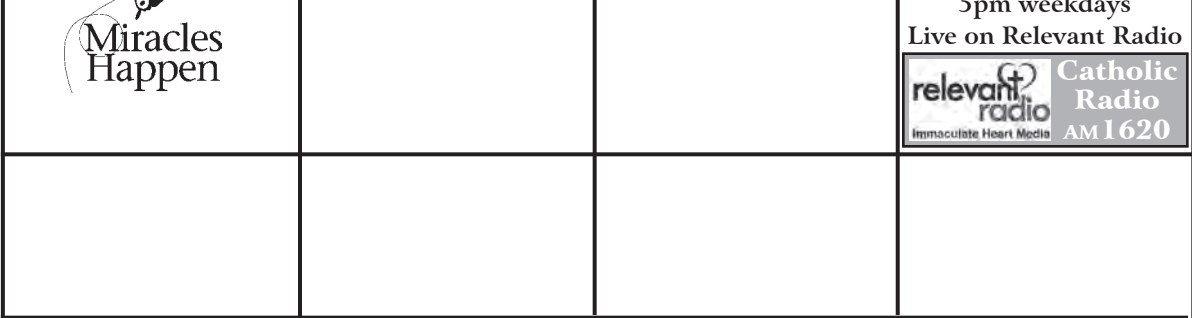
