A Prayer for Mothers


We pray for young mothers, who give life and count toes and tend to our every meed; May they be blessed with patience and tenderness to care for their families and themselves with great joy.


We pray for our own mothers who have nurtured and cared for us; May they continue to guide us in strong and gentle ways.




