<u>Video overview</u>: When St. Paul commands <u>us</u> to "pray always" in 1st Thessalonians, we tend to let it go in one ear and out the other. "Of course, he can't possibly mean that! He must mean that we only need to pray a lot." We so easily filter the words of Scripture based on what we think God wants from us and end up missing his true message. If we understand what prayer truly is, that it's not only reciting the rosary, mental Scripture prayer, or going to Mass. It's being in communion with God. Praying keeps you connected to God, to become a saint as St. Paul says. The vision Jesus gives us of the vine and the branches, is His promise that if we remain in Him, we will bear much fruit. So, if always staying connected to the Lord seems out of reach, then let's remember that when God gives a command, he always gives us the grace to respond. How can we stay attached to the vine and learn to pray always? Learn that in FORMED.

<u>Featured study</u>: *Prayer: A surge of the Heart*. This inspiring presentation challenges us to make more time for God in our lives and highlights the importance of an ever-deepening life of prayer. Make time for this video in your life today.

Topic of Interest: Jesus, the Good Shepherd laid down his life for his sheep. The imagery of the vine as the source of divine life for believers who obey his Word is todays message. Jesus's Farewell Discourse teaches the Apostles about discipleship to carry on His mission on earth, and the key to fruitful discipleship is to abide by obeying him. Those who abide will bear fruit and still will be pruned so they can become even more fruitful. Branches that do not bear fruit will be cut off and burned (Hades). The vine analogy is Jesus' promise of a beautiful intimacy to all those who believe in him but also "the horror" that awaits those who reject him. When we abide in Jesus and nurture our relationship with him, he abides in us and gives us the grace to bear fruit for the kingdom. Further, this mutual abiding is the necessary source of our prayer life so that our wills become aligned with God who will provide what we ask. Bearing good fruit is proof of our discipleship. Since the Father is glorified in the Son and, as his disciples, we share the same mission with Christ, our fruitfulness glorifies the Father. In contrast, those who reject Christ, the life-giving vine, will bear no fruit and will be cut off and thrown into the fire, Hell.
