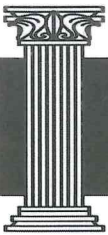
Video Overview: Have you ever felt a tug to do something out of the ordinary? Maybe say something to someone you've never met before or call up an old friend to check in even though it's been years? This tug can make us feel uncomfortable, as we aren't sure why we have this feeling we need to act, but we feel almost disobedient if we don't follow through. Often times, this is the Holy Spirit. He puts things on our hearts in order for us to be Christ to others. Through Baptism and Confirmation, we have the Holy Spirit living in us. Next time you feel prompted to reach out to another, be bold in love and ask the Holy Spirit to give you the courage to follow through.

The Featured "Pick of the Week," is PRESENCE: The Mystery of the Eucharist on FORMED. Please review videos 2: The *Eucharist* again and 3: *Bread for the Journey*; and the lesson's guide for further study. These are a pinnacle achievement when learning more about your faith.

Topics of Interest: Why does Jesus insist in today's gospel that the Disciples are to baptize in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit? Why does this matter? The other issue is when Moses insists that the people fix God's oneness in their heart; how do we relate that to what St. Paul says in Roman's "revealing the shape of our redemption?" Now it's time for you to reconcile Moses' meanings with Paul's message; to get to the climax of God's salvation solution; Jesus. Try to put your answer into words from these two writings. Remember the word *breath* in Hebrew is the Spirit; so how does this hint in Psalm 2 tell us of Jesus and the Spirit?

The GUIDE opens our learning to experience the depth of these Scriptures. Try it once for the whole seven days, and you will understand why those who use the GUIDE decided to make it a habit because of all they gained from it. The GUIDE is the KEY.
