Video Overview: Today's Gospel demands our conversion which is a two-step process. It requires a change of heart and then a turning around of sorts. It is both an interior and exterior change, moving one closer to God. It could be likened to re-aligning yourself to follow your north-facing compass—it first requires knowledge that you are no longer headed north, and then the willingness to change paths in order to head north.

Weekly Featured Pick: "Mary and the Saints" is in Symbolon, session 9, parts 1 and 2; 30 minutes. What do we think of Mary, the Mother of Jesus, and how does our relationship with her impact our relationship with her Son? What is the connection between our understanding of Mary and the rest of the saints?

Topics of Interest: Mk 3, Is Jesus possessed by the Devil? Is a House divided about the Pharisees? God's people divided and conquered themselves, which begs the question; will we ever stop our infighting? Blasphemy against the Holy Spirit; the unforgivable sin; what is the blasphemy? How did the Pharisees cut themselves off from Christ's authority when claiming his miracles were from the Devil? Lott is called brother, but the Jewish term means cousin, think about it, what does Jesus mean when he says, "who are my mother and my brothers?" Is he denigrating Mary? Whom does Jesus call my mother and my brothers? How does that answer bring great fulfillment?

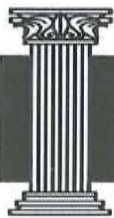

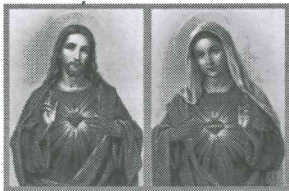

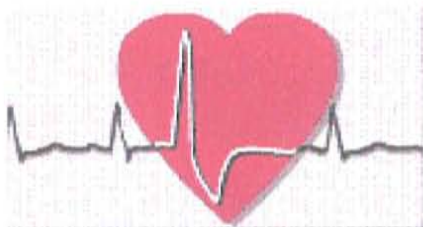
