Video overview: The more we come to know God through study and prayer, the more we realize his thoughts are not our thoughts, nor are our ways his ways (see Isaiah 55). What we assume God would do is so often challenged by how the events of our lives actually unfold. Today's readings draw us into this mystery of God's complete otherness. In Jesus's time the Jewish people were awaiting the Messiah, or Anointed One, who would liberate them from the captivity of the Romans. They were looking for a military warrior who could defeat the enemy by strength of arm and raise up the Israelites to fight alongside him. But God's ways are not our ways. Jesus came and wasn't a military leader, but rather a teacher, healer, and friend. He consistently allowed people to walk away from him when his teachings were too hard. Jesus wasn't concerned with numbers—he chose only twelve men, not an army. And starting with a kingdom the size of a mustard seed, the Church has grown all over the world.

Featured study: FORMED for Mission Episode 5: The Mystery of the Mustard Seed

Topic of Interest: The mystery of the mustard seed should make us pause and reflect. Our fallen human instinct is to go for strength and size. To do a good job, we think that we must reach as many people as possible, or to be perfect in everything we do. Neither of these follows God's logic. He asks that we rely totally on him, instead of our own strength. This can be called the grace of childlikeness, which it is rooted in the virtue of humility. Childlikeness enables us to surrender ourselves completely to the Lord as his child infinitely loved by him. The smaller and more childlike we become, the more God's strength shines through, just like the mustard seed that grows into the mightiest tree. In what ways do you see yourself tending to think more about your own strength, successes, or perfection, as opposed to being God's child and embracing with your littleness?

Bishop Jaime Soto urges Catholics in the Diocese of Sacramento to oppose **Senate Bills 245 & 380**

"The California Senate will be voting on two life threatening bills in the coming weeks. I urge Catholics to tell their state Senator to oppose these two bills that target the vulnerable lives of children and the frail elderly."

Senate Bill 245 seeks to remove co-pay cost sharing for all abortion services and would prohibit cost sharing from being imposed on Medical beneficiaries. Senate Bill 380 would seek to expand access to assisted suicide, eliminate the current safeguards and sunset provisions in the current assisted suicide law.
