Video Overview: Today Jesus describes the relationship between himself, his Father, and the Holy Spirit, where one central point emerges: God’s very life is one of communion. The Trinity is a relationship of giving and receiving, a communion of life and love. God exists as a relationship of Persons. So how should we live our lives? The communion in the Holy Trinity reminds us of the importance of relationships

in our world, and what these relationships should look like in us. We are made in the image and likeness of God, meaning we are to live like the Trinity. Only when we live in self-giving love, like God himself, will we find our fulfillment in life.

Featured Study: type in “self-giving love;” Session 7: A love that Lasts. This 5 Star presentation teaches God’s love, not the love defined by Hollywood.

Topics of Interest: The Last Supper discourse in John’s Gospel, we see part of Jesus’ frank disclosure of the Trinitarian mystery to his disciples by way of the Trinitarian missions. In chapters 14, 15, and 16 Jesus promises the gift of the Holy Spirit to his Church, the “Spirit of truth,” who will “guide you to all truth.” This divine “Counselor” is the shared gift of the Father and Son to continue the work of God in the world after Christ’s Ascension to the right hand of the Father. Jesus even promises that through this “Spirit of truth” he will disclose to his apostles more of the content of the truth which he had been sent to reveal. That is, the Spirit would continue to teach the apostles the full truth of Jesus Christ, the Son of God; and when the time of public revelation comes to a close, the Spirit would continue to guide the Church in understanding all that Jesus had said and done in revealing the truth that the Father had given him to disclose. The Spirit is the one who testifies to the truth of the Son, who himself reveals everything that he had heard from the Father. “Ah, now you are speaking plainly....by this we believe that you came from God” (John 16:29, 30, RSV).

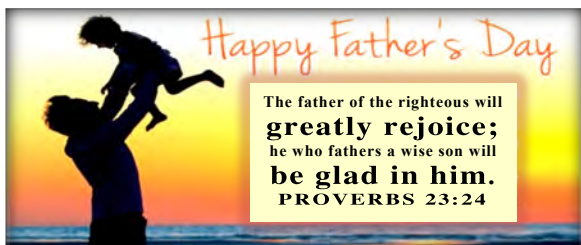

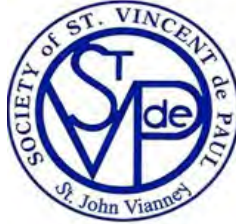

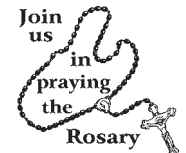
