Video Overview: In the last night of his life, Jesus prayed specifically for one thing for his followers: unity. His followers would witness to his name through their unity and fellowship with one another. In his priestly prayer recorded in John, Jesus asks that all who will come to believe in him might be one. On the darkest night of his life, he is thinking of love and union and what is even more astonishing, he prays for us, his followers two thousand years in the future, that we might be united in him. Union is to be the hallmark of Christians. We are united in Christ as adopted sons and daughters of our heavenly father.

However, we are not fully united. There remains great divisions within Christianity, sometimes even within our own Catholic faith. This week, as you consider the readings, particularly the selection from the Gospel of John, reflect on Jesus' desire for unity among the members of the Body of Christ.

Featured Study: Session 8: The Last Supper and the Cross. Dr. Brant Pitre's incredible understanding of the Mass and the Eucharist, it is all about UNITY! 5 Star.

Topics of Interest: In our first two readings we see confirmed the promise made to believers by Christ in his high priestly prayer from John 17, "that they may see my glory that you gave me." St. Stephen in the midst of a martyr's death in Jerusalem and St. John in the midst of a Confessor's exile on the island of Patmos see his glory, that glory which he had with the Father from before the world was made (John 17:5). These special visions granted to the saints are admittedly rare, but we will all see later what they were granted to see in this life, if we are faithful as they were. In Christ we are even now given access to the love that the Son has for the Father and the Father for the Son. That love is the very procession of the Holy Spirit for whose coming we pray in the Pentecost novena. To be open to his movement is to enter into the mystical unity of the Church with which we are so concerned today. May the prayer of Jesus, the high priest of the new and eternal covenant, be heard by the Father with whom he is one, so that all Christians, of whatever name, may enter into the fullness of faith in the Catholic Church for which he prayed in the hours before his death. While it is incomprehensible that the Father will not answer his prayer, let us strive for charity so that our sins may not impede its early realization in the union of all believers, so that "the world may believe."

The devastation since 2000:

- † ♦34 million Catholics Lost
- † ♦School attendance dropped 37%
- † ♦Adult baptism dropped 51%
- † ♦Parish Child education dropped 67%,
- † ♦Infant baptism dropped 38%,
- † ♦Catholic marriages have dropped 46%.
- † This is a serious BREACH, a gaping hole in Christ’s battle lines.

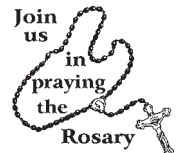
