<u>Video overview</u>: We've all had moments in our lives when chaos seems to reign, and we feel completely out of control. In fact, those moments appear to be rapidly increasing in current times, as everyone seems to be moving more quickly and trying to accomplish more than ever. Our days may seem to be full of storms. What hasn't changed is that God is greater than the storms. He is the one who is truly in control of our lives. But do we really believe that? Every storm we encounter presents another opportunity to trust God and to rely on his providential care.

<u>Featured study</u>: Calming the emotional storms.

Topic of Interest: As we continue through Saint Mark's Gospel, the day of teaching by the sea has concluded, and Jesus suggests crossing over to the other side. It has been a long day, and he falls asleep. Surely, we can sympathize with that. Then a violent storm arises. Yet Jesus continues sleep, even as the boat is filling up with water. When his disciples wake him, he rebukes the wind and the sea—and then there is calm. This is an exercise of divine power, which draws to mind the mighty deeds of the Old Testament, such as the crossing of the Red Sea. So why does Jesus ask the disciples: "Why were you terrified?" It seems obvious, but Jesus wants something more. Jesus uses this moment to draw the disciples into a deeper understanding of how they are to relate to God. If God is with them, then fear has no place. Like the disciples, we should always call upon Jesus in the storm, and he will calm the wind and the waves with his peace. God remains so veiled to us in our world that we can usually get by for a long time thinking that we are in control of our lives. As long as we have everything we need—food, health, shelter, fun, success—we can be pretty quick to forget God. We can start to live under the illusion that we are in control. However, when a storm hits, it can be so shocking that it shakes that illusion to the core.


THROUGH LIFE TRANSITIONS
