Video Overview: Jesus’ miracle of multiplying bread and fish to feed 5,000 men, up to 20,000 people in total with just five loaves and two fish is found in all four Gospels, is one of the most meaningful miracles for all the Gospel writers. The miracle occurs when the apostles trust that Jesus can satisfy the hunger of the people which Christ does in a superabundant manner, with food left over. This miracle serves as a sign pointing towards Jesus’ institution of the Holy Eucharist. His Body and Blood are present after the words of consecration spoken by the priest. In the Eucharist, Jesus is truly present under the appearance of bread and wine; the “Body of Christ.”

Topics of Interest: In Luke’s Gospel there are two instances of Jesus blessing, breaking, and giving bread: in Luke 9, and Jesus’ post-Resurrection appearance to two disciples on the road to Emmaus in Luke 24. The first is a prophecy of, and the second harkens back to, the gift of himself in bread at the Last Supper in Luke 22. In that passage, Jesus breaks and gives bread, but only after he “gave thanks,” where we get the word “Eucharist.” After the feeding of the 5,000, Jesus begins to tell his disciples about his coming Passion, that he must be “delivered into the hands of men” (9:44, RSV) and “suffer many things” (9:22, RSV). Then, near the end of chapter 9, Luke tells us that Jesus’ “face was set toward Jerusalem” (9:53, RSV). In Luke 24, after Jesus broke bread” (24:35), with the two disciples who had been walking away from Jerusalem in despair, now “rose that same hour and returned to Jerusalem” (24:33, RSV). In Luke and Acts, Luke shows Jerusalem is the center of the action, Jesus on the cross and the place from which the apostles launch the proclamation of the Gospel in Acts; and also because it represents for Luke the place of Eucharist, where Jesus, “when he had given thanks” (22:19, RSV), allows himself to be broken and given over into our hands for the life of the world.

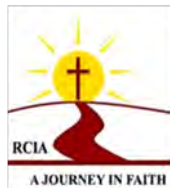

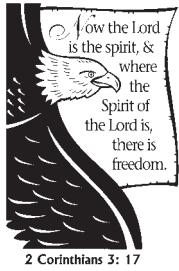

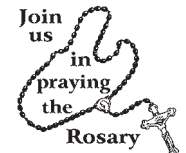
