<u>Video Overview</u>: People desire a sense of fulfillment, a feeling of being loved and cherished. Jesus tells us that "Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." So, the only way we can become truly happy and fulfilled is by giving ourselves in love to God and the people he has placed in our lives. We have to go beyond ourselves, our own selfish interests and sacrifice for others if we are to live the life Jesus has promised. Pope St. John Paul II emphasized, "Man finds himself only by making a sincere gift of himself to others." A rewarding life focuses on the importance of self-giving sacrificial love, Jesus also tells us, "Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me." This has profound implications in today's world, where so many claim to be "spiritual but not religious." Jesus explains that he has invested his authority in his Apostles, the same authority has been handed to the bishops and priests with the result that if we want to accept Jesus in our lives, we must accept the teachings of Jesus's successors and the Church in which they serve. In other words, to be "spiritual," we must also be "religious".

Featured Study: Miracles of Jesus, then pick Session 6: Miracles of Jesus.

Topics of Interest: We see the unity of all the holy ones in Christ. In Matthew, Jesus is bestowing a share in his own authority upon the Apostles as they are sent out. They are warned that the preaching of the truth will evoke a division between those who accept the truth and those who won't. He promises to those who aid Apostles in their mission a share in the reward of the missionary. That is because those whom Christ sends bear him mysteriously within themselves such that to welcome them is to welcome him. St. Luke gives us a parallel text, "He who hears you hears me, and he who rejects you rejects me, and he who rejects me rejects him who sent me" (Luke 10:16). To reject the Apostle is to reject both the Son and the Father! That is the sad state of those who refuse the truth and end up on the wrong side of the division that the Divine Truth introduces among men. But those who hear the truth and aid those who preach it, in even the smallest ways, will have their reward, too.



Welcome Back to the Public Celebration of Mass! Here are some updates:

We are open and I want to assure you that it is safe to come back and celebrate Mass together if everyone consciously follow and abide by the guidelines.





St. John Vianney School plans to be in session five days a week during the 2020/2021 academic year for full academic days from 7:55am to 3:00pm. How is this possible? In addition to social distancing, there are two key aspects to our protocols that are helping to make this possible:

- 1) <u>COHORTS</u>: Students and teachers will remain in stable groups with careful scheduling to prevent interaction with others. Students will eat at their desks, their recesses will be scheduled so their class has their own time and space, and their art and music teachers will utilize Zoom to present their lessons.
- 2) EXCELLENT HYGIENE: Students and teachers will employ excellent hand hygiene and clean the classroom and other frequently touched surfaces frequently. Every student will have a box of tissues, a cleaning rag for each day of the week, a small bottle of hand sanitizer, and a small trash receptacle at their desk. Students will eat their snacks and lunches at their own desks. Learning materials will not be shared among students. Instead every student will have their own set of everything that is needed.

UPDATES ON VIGILS, FUNERAL MASSES & BURIALS DURING THE COVID-19 CRISIS

Catholic Funeral and Cemetery Services (CFCS) offers parishioners the complete range of mortuary services, including cremation, vigils, funeral masses and graveside committal services. These services had been tightly restricted under the shelter-in-place orders, but have now been adjusted as follows.

Vigils, visitations and funeral masses may now all take place at each of our CFCS locations, but with some seating limitations, e.g., St. Mary's Chapel (up to 48 people) and Calvary Mausoleum (up to 100 people). Funeral masses at St. John Vianney must follow the parish's own restrictions (100 maximum).

Graveside committal services are now allowed at each of our CFCS cemeteries for up to 100 people. A perimeter around the grave will be established and up to 8 family members are allowed within that perimeter. All other guests must remain outside the perimeter.


