


Topics of Interest: Context is the Key to Exo 24 with the slaughter and sacrifice of animals, and the Gospel reading on the Eucharist, Last Supper, and sacrifice. The Jews are now free, getting their first taste of promising God to be faithful and if they aren't, then let them be like those animals. Their failing at Idolatry and Jesus' instituting the Eucharist are related, and we can look at Judas and Peter as examples; especially Peter's promise. Try to re-evaluate what Jesus really did for us by referencing the OT to see how we end up trusting in ourselves and not Jesus. Judas is the extreme example of this, and so is Peter, but with major differences in their approach. Think covenant.
