Video Overview: Moses didn't want an abstract knowledge of God, he wanted to know the Person of God, to see God's face, to learn God's name. In response, God reveals his innermost name. So, when Moses learns God's name, he begins to learn God's character as well. Moses talks about God's rich, steadfast love. "The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." In fact, this "mission statement" from Exodus 34 is the most quoted line of the Pentateuch. Throughout their history, the Israelites have held onto God's mercy and from that identity comes God's deeds-his mercy, his kindness, and his steadfast love. Then in the Gospel of John, we get the famous line about God so loving the world, that he gave his only Son. This highlights two of the key actions of God: first his love, and second, his giving. Through this we learn that love is an action, not a feeling, and that love is expressed in sacrificial giving.

Featured Study: Session 6: In the Shadow of the Galilean. Dr Tim Gray masters the thought of the power of the Holy Spirit coming upon St. Peter.

Topics of Interest: God so loved the world..." It's not at all uncommon to see "John 3:16" on placards at sporting events or even on roadside billboards. It has become emblematic of the whole Gospel of Jesus Christ because it tells us in brief about the whole of salvation history and the Father's plan for the human race. In Jesus, the Father's only Son, the Father announces not only his intent to save the world, but also his very divine identity as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In the Person of Christ, these two dimensions of the Gospel, redemption and revelation, are intimately united. By revealing who he is, God simultaneously reveals his sacrificial and saving love. The God who loves us to the end reveals the depth of that love first in his self-revelation to us that he is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Out of the immense fire of love that God is in himself—the eternal exchange of love between the three divine Persons—comes the saving love of Christ's Incarnation. The pierced side of our Savior on the Cross pierces our hearts to reveal the essence of Trinitarian love in its sacrificial nature. The immensity of the divine love, fills us with the confidence that he comes not to condemn the world, but so that we "might not perish but have eternal life."

RESUMPTION OF MASSES

- ◆ Weekday Masses begins on **June 8 at 8am.**
- ◆ Weekend Masses will resume on June 13 & 14.
- ◆ New Weekend Mass times to accommodate disinfecting after each Mass:
 - ⇒ **Saturday Vigil at: 5:30pm**
 - ⇒ **Sunday English Masses at: 8am, 10am & 12pm**
 - ⇒ **Sunday Spanish Masses at: 2pm & 6pm**
- ◆ Physical & Social Distancing must be practiced.
- ◆ One-way traffic will be established in the Church and Hall. Follow the instructions or signs posted.
- ◆ Upon arrival, all parishioners will be screened for temperature.
- ◆ To facilitate contact tracing, all are required to provide their names and phone numbers.
- ◆ Families of same household & individuals must remain 6ft apart from each other.
- ◆ Attendance per Mass will be limited to a maximum of 100 persons, with overflow in the hall for a maximum of 100 persons. To avoid overcrowding, please consider attending one of the weekday Masses.
- ◆ Those over 65, those with pre-existing health conditions, and those who feels safer staying home are encouraged to stay in shelter. Dispensation from Sunday obligation will remain in force.

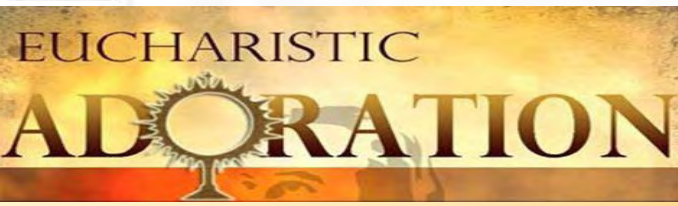
Note: Due to possible Covid-19 restrictions, no more than 15 students will be registered per class. All other students will be placed on waiting list. We will know more when we get closer to September.


