

<u>Video Overview:</u> Look at the miracles of Jesus, like the hemorrhaging woman who reached out in faith, or the raising of the little girl from the Dead. Why aren't we impressed anymore? Would it be different if it had happened to you? Mark first shares Jesus' deeds/miracles of power over sin, sickness, ritual uncleanness, nature, and evil. The 2nd half has Jesus predicting his own passion, death, and resurrection. The **Cross** is the **work of power** that all the miracles point to. It is the ultimate act of healing, forgiving sins, and defeating evil. The way the woman felt when she touched Jesus' robe, was personal and life-altering and yet when we partake in the Eucharist, how many of us walk away with the same personal and life-altering awe of our Lord? It's time to renew our faith, where we really believe and feel Christ in the Holy Eucharist. This is how you pass on the faith to your children.

<u>Featured Study:</u> Miracles of Jesus, session six. Throughout his public ministry, Jesus displayed divine power in the deeds and miracles he performed. Dr. Pitre uncovers the deeper meanings of those miracles—and how they point to the Eucharist. This two-part series has two 25 min videos and over 15 additional sessions. This is the full story of the Eucharist and reflects why Dr. Pitre is one of the top Theologians in the Catholic Church.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Why don't we feel the same way the woman did? Why do we read the Bible but just gloss over the miracles as ho-hum events? What would it take to renew your faith to a level that you would start studying the word every day for an hour like the Pope says?


