

<u>Video Overview:</u> Heroes in our world today are usually the strongest, the smartest, or the most beautiful people who conquer evil by overpowering it in some way. Even if they don't start out that way, a crucial part of their story is usually them preparing for battle by getting stronger. They know that everything is up to *them*. While these stories can be inspiring and get at certain truths, they tend to miss the mark in a big way for Christians: it is in our weakness that we are strong. This is a paradox that troubles and confuses us in deep places that have been unfortunately formed by our culture. We grow up believing that we have to be strong and be the best to bring anything to the table. And when we decide to follow Christ, we bring these beliefs into our discipleship relationship with him.

<u>Featured Study:</u> "Saint Augustine's Confessions in Latin and English." It is an extended poetic, passionate, intimate prayer that Augustine wrote as an autobiography sometime after his conversion, to confess his sins and proclaim God's glory. Just as his first hearers were captivated by his powerful conversion story, so also have many millions been over the following sixteen centuries. His experience of God speaks to us across time with little need of transpositions. This version of Augustine's Confessions contains each "book," or chapter, in the original Latin, followed by the same book translated into English by William Watts.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> What does it mean to exist for God's glory? We must first look to Christ, who is the refulgence of God's glory. In him we find obedience and trust. St. John's Gospel shows that the hour of glory for Jesus is his Passion—the ultimate statement of love and trusting obedience in union with the will of the Father.


