<u>Video Overview</u>: When was the last time you experienced a situation that you thought, "there is no solution—it is impossible". Often we feel cornered by circumstances in life and that there is no possible way out. And yet, miraculously, things all end up working out, for our good. Today's Gospel highlights Jesus' love for his people as he makes a seemingly impossible task of feeding 5,000 people come to fruition with hardly any food to begin. Let's work this week on placing our trust in God's love for us.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Love Unveiled, by Edward Sri. If you were asked what immediately comes to mind when you hear the words "Catholic Church," would you answer "an intimate relationship with the God who loves me?" If not, you would do well to read this engaging and thought-provoking book which explains why such a relationship is the reason for everything the Church does and teaches. Professor Edward Sri will show you how all the pieces of the Catholic faith, including the most baffling ones, fit together to make one beautiful mosaic of God's love for us and our own participation in that all-encompassing love. Using the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* as his itinerary, Sri will walk you through all the essential aspects of the Catholic Church—what Catholics believe about God and the difference it should make in life.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> When we are hungry, we often can't focus or accomplish necessary tasks until we feed ourselves. In this week's Gospel, Jesus recognizes the people's need for both physical nourishment, as he feeds them loaves of bread and fish, and spiritual nourishment, as he renews their minds and hearts with his words. Let us not forget to neglect our soul's need for spiritual food, just as we would not neglect our body's need for food.

SAINT JOHN MARY VIANNEY

Saint John Mary Vianney is familiarly known as the Curé of Ars and as such is the heavenly patron of all parish priests.

He was born of poor parents in Dardilly, France, in 1786. He began his studies for the priesthood at the age of nineteen and only after many failures and difficulties was he ordained in 1815. He was appointed pastor of the village of Ars

where the Faith had practically vanished. Here he labored for the rest of his life gaining a world-

wide reputation as a priest who practiced great penance, exercised a wondrous power in the confessional, and softened the hearts of sinners by his preaching.

After many trials, not the least of which was an obsession by the devil, Father Vianney, exhausted by his labors and his penance, returned his soul to God in 1859. He was canonized in 1929 and his feast is celebrated on August 4.



Immediately after the mass, all are invited to join in the Procession of a statue of our Patron Saint - followed by a celebration in the Parish Hall.




