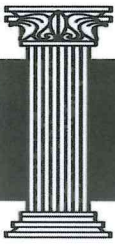

Video Overview: We have all been in need of something at some time, maybe even begging for it. We all have had many experiences of needing to ask for a favor or a need to be met of someone. When it comes to asking God for things, what is it we ask him for? Do we seek comfort - health, wealth, job security, or whatever other dream is the “end all be all” in our minds? Or, do we seek virtues like patience, humility, compassion, meekness, and so on? God will grant us the spiritual gifts we ask for, as we cooperate with his grace and learn to turn to him in our human struggles to master them.

Featured Study: “Seven deadly sins, seven lively virtues.” Join Bishop Robert Barron, as he sheds light on the seven deadly sins—those great spiritual blocks that inhibit our relationship with God and others—and the antidote to them, the seven lively virtues! Bishop Barron uses Dante's *Divine Comedy* to expose these sinful patterns in our lives and show how they are effectively counteracted by the cultivation of virtue through the development of the gifts of the Holy Spirit. This fascinating journey shows the path that God has designed to lead us to health, happiness, and holiness.

Topics of Interest: Today we have a remarkable example of Saint Paul’s faith as he rejoices in his weakness and carries his crosses on his journey to sainthood. Let us ask for his intercession today as we work to become more faith-filled and to find joy in the daily trials we face. Topics are virtue, capital sins and how one overcomes the other.

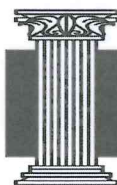
