

<u>Video Overview</u>: Jesus says, "For where your treasure is, there also your heart will be." So, what are your priorities? Can you find them among the many distractions and temptations that takes you away from what's important? If not, then they will create difficulties in your relationships with God, your family, and with those who are in need. Many people may say that they love God, but their actions don't show that to be true. Like the Fig tree that didn't bear fruit, we are good actors, but not good doers. Our treasure should be our families, but instead we're distracted by cell phones, the Internet, TV, Sports, hobbies, etc? This week's readings also call us to almsgiving, to share our treasure, most specifically our financial treasures with those who are in need. The blessings that God gives us are not to be kept for ourselves but are to be given to the poor and those in need.

Featured Study: Session 3: Proclaiming the Kerygma.

<u>Topics of Interest</u>: Jesus instructs his disciples on the skills required for being a watchman, someone prepared for the Lord's return. First, we are to live in the kingdom, not relying on earthly treasure but on that heavenly treasure that is won by almsgiving. We are also to be vigilant, awake, dressed in our attitude and beliefs that show we are attentive for his coming. The whole of Christian history, the history of the Church, is the story of the great night watch. At this point in our collective journey through time, "salvation is nearer to us now than when we first believed" and "the night is far gone, the day is at hand," Romans 13:11-12.


