

<u>Video Overview:</u> In the Gospel readings over the past few weeks we have witnessed the unfolding of Jesus' discourse on the Eucharist. Today we reach the climax of his teaching and get to meditate on his words about the Bread from heaven that he longs to feed us with. These are words of deep richness that unveil to us how desperately God desires intimacy with each one of us.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Finish Session 7: Bread of Life Discourse parts 1 & 2 and the workbooks. Jesus shocked the Jews of his time by offering his own flesh and blood as real food and real drink to gain eternal life. Was he speaking symbolically, as some argue, or did he mean what he said in ways we're still trying to understand?

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> What is your experience of the Eucharist? When did you first understand that the Eucharist is not merely a symbol but truly Christ's Body and Blood? How has your understanding of the Eucharist affected your faith in Christ? Read Dr. Brant Pitre's book, Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist, intro by Scott Hahn and Curtis Mitch. Any Catholic that reads this book will fall in love with the Eucharist for life, whether they believe now or not.
