

<u>Video overview</u>: The word "Christian" literally **means** "follower of Christ." Because we are Christians, we are followers of Christ, but how many of us truly know what that means? Maybe we have never consciously decided to follow him, but we go to Church because of how we were raised or because of our spouse. Unfortunately, many Catholics simply go through the motions in their spiritual life. They may receive their sacraments and celebrate holidays with their families, but is it possible that Jesus wants us to give more of ourselves to him? To follow Christ truly and fully, we can't simply go through the motions. We can't attend Mass and not reverence the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ present in the Eucharist. Jesus doesn't want us to attend Mass only to think about the upcoming football game or work on Monday. He wants us to come to Mass, ready to receive his grace and give ourselves entirely to him. In the Gospel this week, we finish Jesus's discourse on the Eucharist. After he proclaims that we must eat his flesh and drink his blood to gain eternal life, his disciples must make a decision. Many say that his proclamation concerning the Eucharist is a "hard saying," but some remain with him and grow in even deeper friendship with him. The same question faces us this week – will we choose to follow Jesus in all he teaches, even in the hard sayings, or will we abandon him for the easier path?

Featured study: Simon called Peter. By Dom Mauro Giuseppe Lepori.

**Topic of Interest:** In today's society, it is sadly very common to be Christian without maintaining a living relationship with Jesus and intentionally following him. This reality is the result of our sin and our lack of desire to deny ourselves. We must return to Christ as the one who can satisfy all our deepest longings. Being a Christian is not just "part" of our life, but it is our identity. We are children of God, and that defines our whole being. This can be a hard saying for us; we may even resist to giving our hearts completely to God. It is tempting to equate our spiritual lives with attendance at Mass. But our Lord desires so much more for us and invites us into an even greater joy than we can imagine for ourselves.

(The readings today provide a moment for a call to conversion. We are given the choice between following the words of Jesus or choosing our own path. Pray for the boldness to trust in the Holy Spirit, that he might convert your heart. Remember that God has a plan for each of us beyond our sight.

Remind people to keep their faith journey stories to a few minutes. This is only meant to be an initial opening to the Holy Spirit, so the stories should not be long-winded. Be sure to move as quickly as possible into the main part of the study).

#### August 16, 2021 - Diocesan News ON RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION FOR COVID-19 VACCINE

On Friday, August 13, 2021, Bishop Jaime Soto issued the following instructions to the priests and deacons of the Diocese of Sacramento regarding religious exemptions for COVID-19 vaccines:

Dear Brothers:

I instruct you not to sign any letter affirming or granting a religious exemption for those who choose not to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

Doctrinal and moral guidance by both the <u>Congregation for</u> <u>the Doctrine of the Faith</u> at the Holy See and the Doctrine Committee of the <u>United States Catholic Conference</u> have provided the clergy and faithful with clear teaching that Catholic men and women may receive the COVID-19 vaccine in good conscience. Anyone with personal medical concerns about the vaccine should consult with a health care professional.

Both offices have reminded us of the moral obligations of charity. The individual disciple of the Lord Jesus should not only look to one's own personal benefit but also to the common good of public health that will be served by receiving the vaccine.

Anyone who chooses not to receive the vaccination for religious reasons does so on basis of their own personal conscience. The pastor is not obligated to provide his personal or ecclesial endorsement for such a personal choice.
