Video Overview: The word “Christian” literally translates to mean “follower of Christ,” but what does it mean actually to follow him? Maybe we never even consciously decided to follow him, but we have always gone to Church because that’s how we were raised, or that’s what our spouse does. This study will open your eyes to what the Eucharist “Truly” is.

Featured Study is; Lectio: Eucharist. Dr. Pitre, the renowned Notre Dame Seminary Professor and author share his 10-part series with us to open up the Jewish roots of the Eucharist and the Christians role in it since Jesus gave us the Bread of Life discourse. The Eucharist is more than just the phrases we know from the Mass; it is life itself. Dr. Pitre explores the greater and deeper context of Scripture and Church teachings in the biblical roots of the Eucharist, through its foreshadowing in the miraculous events of the Old Testament, the Gospels, and Apostolic teaching. We'll discover firsthand how Christ's Body and Blood are an integral and wondrous part of God's plan for our salvation.

Topics of Interest: The Lectio Eucharist is the study for the next ten weeks. If none practicing Catholics knew the information in this series, they would be “Practicing” Catholics. This series will enlighten your adult children and those who have left the Church; that there is a difference between Catholics and Protestants.




