

<u>Video Overview:</u> Have you ever asked yourself why God doesn't just perform miracles all the time to reveal his presence so that everyone will believe in him? It's a valid question, but these questions have answers in Catholic theology, as is seen in Exodus 16 and John 6 when showing how people came for the miracles not because of faith. God does not ordinarily reveal himself through miracles, but through more gradual ways that invite us into deep friendship with him. We tend to ask for miracles that provide for our physical and worldly needs, but God is more concerned for our spiritual well-being and our eternal life; therefore, our spiritual well-being may not entail physical healing. In the Gospel today, Jesus chides the Israelites for seeking only earthly fulfillment. He calls them, and likewise us, to open our hearts to our deeper desire for God. Ultimately, God wants to fill our deepest longings for his infinite love.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Session 6: Miracles of Jesus. Throughout his public ministry, Jesus displayed divine power in the many miracles he performed. Dr. Pitre uncovers the deeper meaning of those miracles—and how they enlighten our understanding of the Eucharist.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Exodus 16 and John 6. Both are examples of the thought that God would use miracles to give us faith and instead he taught obedience, love, and faith. Exodus 16 shows us how those who followed the miracles didn't enter the promised land, but those that obeyed him did. The same goes for John 6 where Jesus shows them they were really only interested in a free lunch.




