Video Overview: Today we see people vying for places of honor; Jesus, however, challenges us to do just the opposite: to seek the “lowest place;” by asking Christians to outdo one another in the practice of true humility. Real honor comes from seeking the glory of God, not the praise of men. Worldly honors, the trophy, the new position, the praise from your boss, and the time visiting with a famous person will not fulfill us. This quest for worldly glory distracts us from finding our true identity and fulfillment in life which comes from God alone. If we seek the “lowest place” with sincerity, we will have more room for God in our hearts. And God will give us the ultimate reward—a place in his presence forever.

Featured Study: Search for “Humility.” Choose Beatitude Series; Session 2: Blessed are the Poor in Spirit.

Topics of Interest: Jesus is attending a dinner and then gives two lessons, one to the invited guests and one to the host, about how to dine in the kingdom. The parable is about a rich landowner and the banquet he throws. The lessons teach that the humble are favored and those who have some status should seek the lowest place at table. As St. Paul says; “Have the same regard for one another; do not be haughty but associate with the lowly; do not be wise in your own estimation” (Rom 12:16). Those who host should invite the lowly who cannot repay, so that God can repay. This is a common Old Testament and rabbinical theme, that God pays the debts of the poor, compensating those who give alms. Lastly, Jesus tells a parable about a landowner who follows a very different pattern of hospitality and throws a party inviting his own class of people, none of whom accepts his invitation. So, he sends his servants to bring in “the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind” (Lk 14:21). When his house is still not full, he asks that everyone his servants can find be pressed to come, finishing with the phrase, “For, I tell you, none of those men who were invited will taste my dinner” (Lk 14:24). The common interpretation of the Pharisee described as “observing” Jesus, to catch Jesus in some infraction of the Law, will find their covenant invitations pulled and their places given to lowly covenant outsiders who will respond better to the compulsion of God’s grace and enter the heavenly banquet.

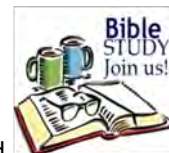

Effective **September 1st, 2019**, all room reservations for the Hall, Church, Fr. Moroney Room, Fr. McKeon Room, Sr. Bede Room and Unity Room will be handled by the Parish Office (Front Desk).

Below is the Diocesan guidelines (provided by Tom McNamara, Chief Financial Officer) for the usage of the Parish Hall:

- The simple rule is that use of a parish hall is for parish activities only; e.g. parish ministries and school.
- This includes a celebration associated with a sacrament; e.g. a wedding reception, funeral reception or baptism.
- All other private or non-parish events are not allowed for the purpose of maintaining the parish's property tax exempt.
- A parish hall cannot be seen as a fundraising vehicle.

Therefore we will not be able to accommodate any booking for:

- Outsiders/non-parish events and receptions.
- Private events; e.g. birthdays, baby showers or private graduation parties.

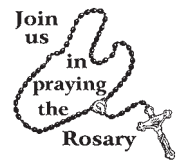
