

<u>Video Overview:</u> Winter can be depressing, you may not even get to see the sun for months. It can be bone-chillingly cold, with little sign of life except for the brave neighbors who shovel their driveways. The trees are lifeless, and we don't hear children playing outside, or birds chirping, and it appears to be desolate. Carrying our cross is often a "winter" for our soul. It can be challenging, lonely, and feel never-ending. The hope that we have in Christ is for the springtime that is to come. We carry our cross and accept death to ourselves so that we can experience the Resurrection with him. The budding of flowers and leaves on the trees, the warmth of the sun, and life coming to bloom again. But in order to experience this beautiful springtime, we must first go through the trial of winter as Jesus did in the Eucharist.

Featured Study: Lectio: Eucharist, Session 4 the Miracles of Exodus. Manna and water.

Topics of Interest: "If anyone wishes to come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me" (Lk 9:23). It is a demanding requirement that even unsettled the disciples and throughout the ages, has prevented people from following Christ and yet has also produced examples of sanctity and martyrdom that strengthened and confirmed the way of the Church. Even today these words are regarded as a stumbling block to many (1 Cor 1:22-25). There are not two pathes, only one: the one trodden by the Master. The disciple cannot invent a different way. (Pope JP II)
