Video overview: In this week’s Gospel, Jesus is nearing the end of his journeys with his disciples. Soon after these events, he will turn towards Jerusalem to face his Passion. He is beginning to pull his Apostles aside for intimate moments, revealing more deeply his heart, teachings, and mission on earth. The Apostles have spent almost three years with Jesus, but here it is evident that they still don’t fully know him. It can be challenging to watch them misunderstand Jesus so many times, but we can relate to them more than we realize. Because Jesus is God, there will always be things about him that we cannot fully understand because our minds are finite. Moreover, the ways of God are not like our ways. His kingdom, his mission, and his promises aren’t what we expect. The logic of the Gospel is the logic of God, not of humans. Today, Jesus wants to pull us aside for an intimate moment to reveal his heart more deeply to us and to teach us his logic that will lead to our true joy, just as he did for his Apostles.

Featured study: The Search//Episode 7//Why a Church

Topic of Interest: When Jesus starts to unveil his suffering and death to his disciples, they are baffled. The Israelites had been waiting for liberation from the tyranny of other nations and the restoration of the Promised Land for hundreds of years. How could the promised Messiah suffer and die? What would it mean for them and their people? How was God going to fulfill his promises and bring liberation to them? The Israelites were looking for the wrong kind of Messiah. While they were hoping for liberation from political enemies, God was going to give them liberation from sin, and he was going to restore the tribes of Israel in a spiritual way. God was working to free them from spiritual oppression for all eternity! We misunderstand God this way even today. So many times, we bring him our desires for this world rather than our desires for the next – our desires for a good grade, a good job, or even good health are ultimately smaller than our deepest desire for God and eternal life. When you ask God for things in prayer, what kinds of requests do you make?



From the Pastor

Protocol for Indoor Masses Effective July 31, 2021

- Face coverings shall be worn, regardless of vaccination status, over the mouth and nose, in all indoor public settings, venues, gatherings and workplaces. Hand sanitizer is available.

- All the Catholic Faithful in the Diocese of Sacramento are obliged to personally attend and actively participate in the Sunday celebration of the Sacrifice of the Mass (Canon 1247).
- Individuals who are sick or have a vulnerable health condition or are caring for someone with a vulnerable health condition are not obligated to attend the Eucharist on Sunday or other obligatory solemnities.
- All the faithful are encouraged to receive the COVID-19 vaccination when available. Please consult your doctor regarding any personal health concerns.

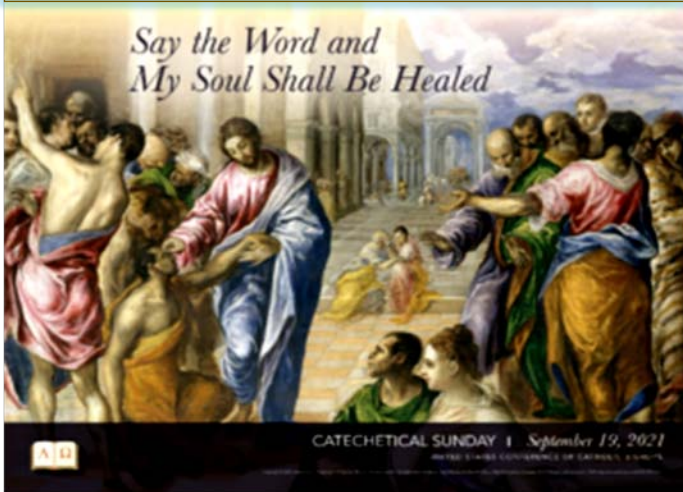

The Prayer and Life Workshop

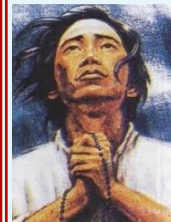
