<u>Video Overview:</u> God desires our whole hearts, not simply our actions. We can do good acts but still keep our hearts far from him, just like when we are at Mass, and we just go through the motions. Remember the Early Fathers expected this and positioned "Lift up you hearts," as central to the Mass, as the heart in the Bible is not just a vital organ but the center of all of our attention, affections and actions which flow from the Heart; this is our wakeup call the sacred words of consecration. The power of Jesus' resurrection can transform us overtime to actually become more like him. Then our actions will flow seamlessly from who we are in our hearts.

Featured Study: Lectio: Eucharist, session 2 the Garden of Eden and sacrifice.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> The Father didn't send His Son so that we could live lukewarm lives, hiding behind the profile of being a "good person" who in reality doesn't deny themselves completely and give themselves to God. His plan involves us being in a deep and profound personal relationship with Him so that he can transform us into the likeness of his Son, not us living in mediocrity. This transformation is critical so that we don't live with the following attitude: "I can live however I want as long as I don't hurt anybody." God asks more from us than that, so if we live our lives in accordance with the truths of the Gospel, then he will give us joy everlasting.
