



<u>Video Overview</u>: In this week's Gospel, Jesus is nearing the end of his journeys with his disciples. Soon after these events, he will turn towards Jerusalem to face his Passion. He is beginning to pull his Apostles aside for intimate moments, revealing more deeply his heart, teachings, and mission on earth. The Apostles have spent almost three years with Jesus, but here it is evident that they still don't fully know him. It can be challenging to watch them misunderstand Jesus so many times, but we can relate to them more than we realize. Because Jesus is God, there will always be things about him that we cannot fully understand because our minds are finite.

Featured Study: Lectio: Eucharist, session 5 Mysteries of the Tabernacle.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> The ways of God are not like our ways. His kingdom and promises are from a pure mind. The logic of the Gospel is the logic of God, not of humans. Today, the Pope tells us to read the Bible daily so that we can be aligned with the logic of God and not our worldly hearts. We need the daily course corrections that Scripture provides. Jesus teaches us His logic will lead to our true joy, just as he did it for His Apostles. "My yoke is easy and my burden light"? What is the yoke He is talking about? Church teachings tell us Jesus was referring to the "yoke of faith." So, how is your faith?


