<u>Video overview:</u> Catechists, we can often become so passionate about the details of the Catholic Faith that we want to impart to our students that we forget that our faith is in a real person, Jesus Christ. We can forget that our work as catechists is not to present our own truth, but the truth of Jesus Christ and the reality of his Incarnation. In the Last Super discourse, Jesus tells us that he is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Today's readings invite us to meditate on what it means that he is the Truth. What are the ramifications of the truth being a set of rules that has the Person of Jesus Christ as its divine author? To the extent that we see Jesus, recognize him, know him, and commune with him we are able to see things in the truth and perceive reality clearly. The more we know him and love him, the more we know and love the truth in all things.

Featured study: The Good News: God has sent His Son.

Topic of Interest: Our society professes an entirely different philosophy than the one of the Truth of the Gospel – many believe that there is no truth and it is impossible to know the truth. Have you ever heard someone say something along the lines of, "How could one faith be true and the other not? What faith you hold is just random chance. Of course, you think yours is right and theirs is wrong!" This relativistic mindset proposes that there cannot be one truth, because not everyone knows the truth. This thought process tragically leads many people to stop seeking truth, and thus to lose a real sense of meaning and purpose in their lives. Christianity is the counter to relativism. Christianity proposes Jesus Christ as the Truth, and this Person desires to be in a living relationship with us so that we can truly know him. The Truth is knowable, because Jesus has revealed himself to us! This is a hopeful message in a world full of hopelessness. How have you experienced these worldly ideas about relativism? Have you noticed this kind of thinking in yourself or in others around you?



Protocol for Indoor Masses Effective July 31, 2021

- Face coverings shall be worn, regardless of vaccination status, over the mouth and nose, in all indoor public settings, venues, gatherings and workplaces. Hand sanitizer is available.

- Individuals who are sick or have a vulnerable health condition or are caring for someone with a vulnerable health condition are not obligated to attend the Eucharist on Sunday or other obligatory solemnities.
- All the faithful are encouraged to receive the COVID-19 vaccination when available. Please consult your doctor regarding any personal health concerns.

At Saint John Vianney School, we believe in the academic, social, and emotional growth of every child, so much so that we have 2 full-time staff on-site in our Enrichment Center. They help identify student needs, advocate for all learners so they can perform at their best, and support parents and teachers as they help children grow and learn. The Enrichment Center works with families, teachers, and administration to facilitate Student Study Team (SST) meetings. The Enrichment Director also works in partnership with parents and the public school to support and advocate for student services such as Speech Therapy, Psychoeducational Assessments, Occupational Therapy, and Social/Emotional Growth Plans also known as Behavior Plans. The Enrichment Director, along with the Homeroom Teacher and Principal, will attend public school IEPs to ensure accommodations can be put in place to support a student with an SLD (Student Learning Disability) or identified medical need determined by a 504 plan.




