

To the extent that we see Jesus, recognize him, know him, and commune with him we are able to see things in the truth and perceive reality clearly. The more we know him and love him, the more we know and love the truth in all things.

Featured Study: Lectio: Eucharist, session 6, the Miracles of Jesus.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> We can often become so passionate about the details of the Catholic Faith that we want to impart to others, that we forget that our faith is in a real person, Jesus Christ. In the Last Super discourse, Jesus tells us that he is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Today's readings invite us to meditate on what it means that he is the Truth. What are the ramifications of the truth being a set of rules that have the Person of Jesus Christ as its divine author? To the extent that we see Jesus, recognize him and commune with him we are able to see things in the truth and perceive reality clearly. The more we know him and love him, the more we know and love the truth in all things. Today's Gospel tells us that it has never been easy to understand all of Jesus' teachings, even for those who heard him in person.
