<u>Video overview:</u>: Have you ever been so sick that you needed to rely on a family member or a friend to help you get to the doctor? Sometimes, we are unable to be healed on our own. We need someone else to bring us. Today we will read about a man who was brought to Jesus and how grateful was to those who loved him enough to present him before the Divine Physician.

Featured study: Mother Teresa: Seeing the face of Jesus.

Topic of Interest: Some people bring a sick man to Jesus in today's healing story. Jesus receives the sick man on behalf of the people who bring him. Notice the great faith of those who brought the man to Jesus: they did not ask Jesus to heal him specifically but trusted him to the Great Physician. Who do you need to bring to Jesus for healing? Do you need healing yourself? Do you not trust Jesus to heal the wounds of the world, but rather attempt to fix everything yourself? Let's take a few minutes now to be in the place of the man who is healed. He has not been able to hear his entire life, nor does he have the ability to speak well. Jesus's actions must seem very strange to you. But then, the unthinkable happens you hear people's voices, you hear leaves in the wind and birds going about their day. Protocol for Indoor Masses Effective July 31, 2021




September 18, 2021 - Six Flags Discovery Kingdom
