

<u>Video Overview:</u> When was the last time you were so sick you had to rely on a family member or friend to help get you to the doctor? Sometimes, we aren't able to get the healing we need on our own. We need someone else to bring us. Today we will read about a man who was brought to Jesus, and how grateful he must have been to those who loved him enough to present him before the Divine Physician.

<u>Featured Study</u>: Lectio: Eucharist, session 3 The Lamb of God. Why? Why a Lamb? Why God's Lamb? When John the Baptist calls Jesus by this title for the second time in John 1:36, two of his disciples leave to start following Jesus. They don't seem surprised or confused by the title. Were they expecting this lamb? Could you explain this to someone about why the Jews were expecting a lamb.

<u>Topics of Interest:</u> Find out what the Jews knew and why, especially considering Isaiah 35:4 and Matt 11:5. We all need God's healing touch in our lives. We may look to self-help books, diets, exercise routines, or even "new age" ways to find for the peace we desire. Today, we are reminded that Jesus Christ is the only one to whom we should look for healing. He wants us to give our entire lives to him, because he will ultimately be able to satisfy the desire of our hearts. The Jews, the Apostles all knew this, do you?
