

#### April 16, 2023, Second Sunday of Easter—Formed.org.

Review: The second Sunday after Easter is designated Divine Mercy Sunday. It's a recent feast in the Church, instituted in 2000 by Pope St. John Paul II. He felt that immediately after Easter, while the Paschal mysteries were fresh in our hearts, we needed an opportunity to reflect more deeply on God's great mercy manifested in the Resurrection. So how does this feast fit with the Gospel reading of Jesus's appearance in the Upper Room? When the reading begins, the disciples are hiding in fear for their lives, certain that the officials would be coming to get them just as they came for Jesus. Compounding their fear is the recognition that they had abandoned Jesus in his hour of greatest need. They are scared, disgraced, and guilty. At that very moment, who should enter into their sorrow and shame but Jesus himself Jesus comes. Jesus comes, despite the locked doors, to stand in their midst, offering them both peace and mercy. In addition, he tells them that through the power of the Holy Spirit, they, too, will have the ability to extend mercy by forgiving sins. Today, through our priests who have been ordained in apostolic succession, we, too, can receive mercy and forgiveness. All we need to do is repent and trust in the mercy of God. Indeed, today's feast invites us to trust that no matter what wrong we may have done, Jesus loves us and wants us to experience his mercy. That's why one simple prayer associated with Divine Mercy devotion sums up the confidence we should have in Christ's mercy: "Jesus, I trust in you."

Featured study: Could God ever love Someone like Me?

Reflection: As a Church we're present on Easter morning to witness the risen glory of Jesus Christ. We share the joy and recognition of St. Mary Magdalene and the Apostles. But just as we're represented collectively as a Church in the characters of Mary Magdalene and the Apostles, so are we also absent and doubting on that first Easter day in the person of Thomas. The Second Sunday of Easter could be called Thomas's Easter. He represents that part of us that holds out against faith-relentlessly asking for proof and confirmation. Because of this, Thomas is a particularly good model for our age. He demands an empirical, tangible demonstration that Jesus is risen in the flesh. In John's Gospel, seeing is believing. John seems to emphasize the evidence that sight supplies to the identity of the Lord Jesus. Sight and blindness are metaphors for enlightenment and non-believers.

It is a significant time for reflection on the Christian faith. As Pope John Paul II stated, "It is a time where we are blessed with divine mercy as it reaches us through the heart of Christ crucified." Divine Mercy Sunday focuses on the gifts that flowed from Christ's death, burial, and resurrection — his mercy and love that were so freely given to humanity after such a betrayal. Divine Mercy Sunday concludes the Easter celebrations and welcomes the ultimate gift that Christ gave after his crucifixion.



## **Vatican News**

'Pope at Audience: Resentment and sadness must not infect our lives'

Addressing the faithful gathered in St Peter's Square for his weekly General Audience, Pope Francis reflected on the Passion of the Lord that we heard on Palm Sunday, and in particular, on the final words of the gospel passage: "They sealed the stone". The Holy Father noted that everything seemed over and that, for the disciples, the boulder signified the final end of their hope. The Teacher was crucified, killed in the cruelest and most humiliating manner, hung upon the infamous gallows outside the city - a public failure, the worst possible ending.

The Pope recalled that, today, this discouragement seems normal as we too have gloomy thoughts and frustrating feelings. "Even today, hope sometimes seems to be sealed behind the stone of mistrust," said the Pope.

The Holy Father then went on to note that there was one image which remained fixed in the minds of the disciples, "the cross". "That is where the end of everything was centered," he explained. However, he continued, "in a little while, they would discover a new beginning right there, in the cross."

..Pope Francis then used the cross as an example of this, saying that "out of the most terrible instrument of torture, God wrought the greatest sign of His love."

Pope Francis then encouraged Christians to look to the cross as the "tree of life", so that we might be healed of that sadness that makes us ill.





#### **Baptisms:**

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

#### **Bautizos:**

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

#### Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

#### Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

#### First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

#### **Primera Comunion:**

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

#### Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.
