



Review: Imagine an ant colony. The ants decide that they need to build a new hill and choose to do so at the busiest intersection downtown. You deeply love your ants, and so you try to instruct them that this is not a good idea, but as you get close to talk to them, they scurry away in a frenzy and then go back to gathering supplies to build their ant hill at the intersection. You think to yourself, "What must I do in order to get across to these ants that if they build at this intersection, they will die? How can I save them?" And then it dawns on you-you must become an ant. This is the only way they will listen to you without fear. You become an ant and work to lead them away from the busy intersection. Some follow you, others can't stand you and choose to put you to death. As silly as this little story may sound, it helps show the radical love that Christ has for us. He needed to reach us, to come in a way that we would recognize him and hear his voice, and so God made himself a mere human. What amazing love Our Lord has for us! Let us spend some time together today reflecting on this love as we read of it in the first two readings and then as we hear of Christ as our good shepherd, keeping us safe from harm.

Featured study: Jesus: the word became flesh.

Reflection: In this passage, Jesus uses the analogy of a shepherd to characterize his deep love and concern for the people as opposed to the Pharisees who are more concerned with the Law. Jesus has just given sight to a man blind from birth and who the Pharisees subsequently persecute shamefully. With the claim "I am the Good Shepherd," Jesus evokes the words that God spoke from the burning bush to Moses in Exodus 3:14 and thereby asserts his spiritual authority. He then proves his care and concern for the people by his readiness to lay down his life for them not merely by risking it. In contrast, the Pharisees show no true concern for the people; they are like hired hands who quit their post at the first sign of trouble. As the Good Shepherd, Jesus desires an intimate relationship with his sheep, modelled after the relationship that he has with the Father. Although Jesus has authority, there is an interdependence based on love and obedience. Jesus hears and freely responds to the command of the Father to lay down his life and to pick it up again. We too are called to hear his voice and respond in obedience to the great love that he shows us in laying down his life for us.







BACK IN THE ATRIUM

Baptism, the gift of Light, the gift from God.

At this time in the Atrium we contemplate baptism. We know that the Paschal Candle is the sign of Jesus. Jesus is the Light of the World and we receive baptism as a gift from God. Through Baptism we become the children of the Light, the children of God. The white dress of baptism symbolizes the purity of heart and also that we have received

the light of the Risen Christ, or a gift of light. The elements of baptism we will talk about are the Paschal Candle symbolizing Jesus, the white dress that shows we have received the light of Christ, and the solemn blessing that parents receive to be strengthened in fulfilling their promise.

Vatican News

By Deborah Castellano Lubov, Apr. 10, 2024 Pope at Audience: Grace-sustained fortitude helps us daily

"May Jesus and the saints' examples, inspire us to rediscover fortitude, which will, with God's grace, help us in our daily efforts...

Pope Francis gave this encouragement during his weekly General Audience on Wednesday in St. Peter's Square. This week, the Pope continued his catechetical series on vices and virtues. After months dedicated to the vices, he transitioned to discussing virtues, thus far focusing on prudence, patience, justice, and now, fortitude. The Catechism describes the cardinal virtue of fortitude

as "the moral virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good."

Turning to the virtue, the Pope highlighted how it strengthens the resolve to resist temptations and to overcome obstacles in the moral life, and enables one to conquer fear, even fear of death, and to face trials and persecutions." Most of the fears that arise within us, he observed, are unrealistic, and do not end up happening anyway. "It is better, then," he said, "to invoke the Holy Spirit and face everything with patient fortitude: one problem at a time, as we are able, but not alone!"

"The Lord is with us, if we trust in Him and sincerely seek the good," the Holy Father reassured, saying, "in every situation we can count on God's providence to shield and armor us."


