Review: The two disciples on the road to Emmaus in today's reading came to know the Lord in the "breaking of the bread" the Eucharist. We can see that their encounter with Jesus that day parallels the way Jesus comes to meet us in every Mass. First, just as Jesus spoke to the two disciples on the road about the Scriptures, so Jesus speaks to us through the Scriptures in the Liturgy of the Word. Then, just as Jesus explained the Scriptures to the disciples on the road, so do we have those words interpreted for us by the priest so that we can begin to understand what they mean for our lives. The first half of the Mass, like the first half of the journey to Emmaus, focuses on the Word of God. Then, as we experience the "breaking of the bread," Jesus gives us his very self, his Body and Blood. At that moment, our eyes can be opened, and we are able to see Jesus in our midst. When we receive the Lord with an open and receptive heart, we know that he is alive ... and with us. We begin to have a glimpse into the awesome plan of God for our own lives. The second half of the Mass, like the second half of the Emmaus story, centers on meeting and recognizing Jesus.

Featured study: The Road to Emmaus

Reflection: In this reading, we see Jesus seeking two disciples who are leaving Jerusalem in despair over Jesus's death and apparent failure. Jesus's meticulous care in gathering up and confirming his disciples in faith after his Resurrection ought to give us great confidence in his love for all, even those who have walked away from him. The lesson for us is that without the gift of faith, even the obvious can seem obscure. This story in Luke also gives us some direction as to where to find the grace necessary to overcome our ignorance. We're told that in the "breaking of bread" they recognized him. That term is widely considered to have been a kind of code term in the early Church for the celebration of the Eucharist. This narrative itself exhibits a form like that of the Mass. It begins with a Liturgy of the Word: "Beginning, then, with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them what referred to him in all the Scriptures." It closes with the "breaking of the bread," as happens in the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Through the Sacraments generally, and the daily Sacrament of the Eucharist particularly, the Church learns to see clearly what was formerly obscure.



Vatican News

'Pope: God's mercy never abandons us, even as world

"Today, as the world is increasingly tried by wars and straying from God, we need the Mercy of the Father even more." Pope Francis made that appeal for peace on Wednesday as he spoke to pilgrims gathered in St. Peter's Square for the weekly

In his greetings to Polish-speaking pilgrims, the Pope recalled the upcoming celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday.

The Solemnity of Divine Mercy was instituted by St. John Paul II "as desired by the Lord Jesus and expressed through St. Faustina Kowalska nearly a century ago."

Pope Francis continued his prayer for the world by quoting the prayer from the Divine Mercy chaplet: "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world." Near the end of the audience, he added that the Lord "never ceases to be merciful."

"Let us think about the mercy of God, which always welcomes and accompanies us, and never leaves us on our own," he said. Pope Francis also recalled the 60th anniversary of Pope St. John XXIII's 1963 encyclical Pacem in Terris, which bore the subtitle "On establishing universal peace in truth, justice, charity, and liberty". He noted that the landmark encyclical dedicated to peace was written at the height of tensions during the Cold War. John XXIII, said Pope Francis, opened up for everyone the

possibility to speak about peace and laid out the parameters for

Join with the Diocese of Sacramento's Ministry for Catholics with disAbilities in this special Mass!


The Diocese of Sacramento Ministry for Catholics with disAbilities is hosting a sensory-friendly Mass.






Coming Back to our Atrium

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.
