Review: Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! Divine Mercy Sunday was officially instituted in 2000 by Pope St. John Paul II. In the 1930's, Jesus appeared to a young Polish nun (now St. Faustina) and entrusted the message of Divine Mercy to her in a particular way for our time. Our world is full of so much evil, and Our Lord wants to remind us of his Divine Mercy and the need for repentance. This Sunday is also the last day of the Octave of Easter, and so, in a sense, it is the climax of our celebration of Easter. As we reach the height of our Easter octave, the readings focus on God's mercy. Why is that? God's merciful love is the Good News of the Gospel, and the reason why Christ suffered, died, and rose again. The Catechism goes so far as to say that, "The Gospel is the revelation in Jesus Christ of God's mercy to sinners" (CCC 1846). God's mercy reached down to us in our sinful state and sent us a Savior, who took on human flesh so that we might have life with him.

Featured study: **Could God Ever Love Someone like Me?** By Fr. Mike Schmitz

Reflection: In this passage, John demonstrates how faith conquers the world by linking belief in Christ with the command to love. To be a true Christian, we must believe that Jesus of Nazareth is the Messiah sent by the Father. Only through the revelation of the Son can we come to believe in God as Father. To love the Father is to love the Son and those united to him. We fulfill this love for the Father (and for each other) by our obedience to God's commandments. Since this obedience is born out of love, it should not be burdensome and should testify to our faith. Since the same Spirit who testifies at Jesus's baptism also testifies at his death, we can have confidence that Jesus is the pre-existent Son who came "through water and blood" to show us the way to eternal life. Through Baptism, we share in the Death and Resurrection of Christ by dying to our old self and being born anew into the life of Christ. The grace of Baptism enables us to become disciples of Christ and living witnesses of Christ through our love of God and neighbor.

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, ponder the profound significance of this new form of devotion for the Church and world today. We need God's abundant Divine Mercy to flow from the gates of Heaven upon us more than ever. Only in Heaven will we understand the full depths of God's Mercy. For now, we must trust all that He has revealed through his humble servant Saint Faustina and respond to the requests He has given to us through her. Commit yourself to the various ways God has called us to call upon His Mercy and do so with as much vigor and devotion you can offer Him.

The following is the 3 o'clock prayer Jesus gave to Saint Faustina:

Prayer: *You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us (#1319). Jesus, I trust in You.*

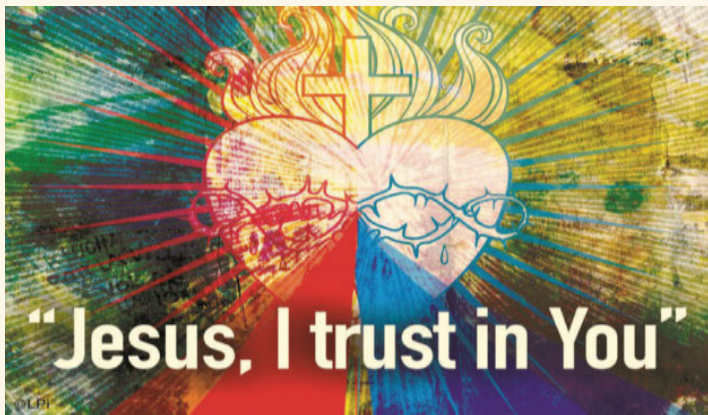

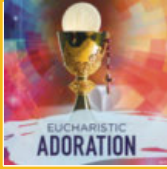

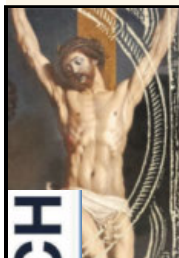

On Sunday, March 31, we were home celebrating with our families the big feast of Easter. Our last session was Thursday, March 21st. We now go on our two week vacation to continue our preparation and celebration for this great feast. We remember that first we experienced Lent, then Holy Week which ended with Easter. Easter is the Resurrection

of our Lord Jesus, His Victory over death and salvation for humanity. Easter Season begins with Easter Sunday, continues for 40 days and will end on Ascension Sunday, when Jesus goes back to His Father in Heaven. Before leaving, Jesus said to His apostles that it was necessary for Him to go so that He could send the Holy Spirit. Ten days after Jesus' departure, He sent The Holy Spirit and we celebrate that day as Pentecost Sunday. God always does what He promises!

Pope Francis: Youth are living hope of a Church on the move

The “certainty” that “Christ is alive and He wants you to be alive” has inspired Pope Francis to write again to young people, on the fifth anniversary of his Apostolic Exhortation, *Christus vivit*, written in the wake of the 2018 Synod on “young people, faith, and vocational discernment.” “Above all,” Pope Francis says in the message released on Monday, “I would like my words to be a source of renewed hope” to young people who may feel discouraged in a world “marked by so many conflicts and so much suffering.”

The Holy Father assures young people that “Christ is alive and He loves you with an infinite love.” The Holy Father invites them to “walk with Him as a friend, welcome Him into your life, and let Him share all the joys and hopes, the problems and struggles of this time in your life.”

He goes on to remind people of the “great mission” they have received “to bear witness before everyone to the joy born of friendship with Christ,” reminding them of his invitation to make their voices heard and his encouragement to “make a mess,” famously expressed in Spanish as “¡Hagan lío!”

Living in the presence of Jesus, the Pope tells young people, will allow their “memory of the past” to prove fruitful and help them to “find courage in the present” and “face the future with hope.” ...Reminding the youth that they are “the living hope of the Church on the move,” Pope Francis thanks them for their presence in and contribution to the life of the Church.

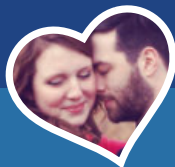

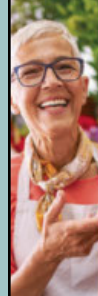

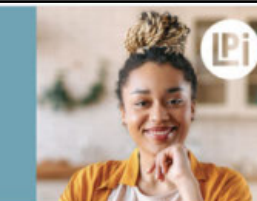
