

# FORMED

## OUR VISION

### Aug 6 Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord — Formed.org.

**Review:** All four of today's Scripture readings focus on the glory and majesty of Jesus as king. His glorious kingship is foretold by the prophet Daniel in the vision he receives of "one like a Son of man" receiving an everlasting dominion from God. In the Responsorial Psalm we sing to our Lord who is king over all the earth. In the second letter of St. Peter, we actually get a firsthand account from Peter of what we will hear about again in the Gospel reading from St. Matthew—the glory and majesty that Peter witnessed on the Mount of the Transfiguration. Together all of these Scripture passages point toward the divinity of Jesus Christ, one of the most important points of our faith as Christians. This key doctrine is also a great mystery: How can Jesus be fully God and fully man? How well do we understand this claim? Can we explain it and defend it? Today we step aside from our struggle to understand and seek to just be with God. The Transfiguration was a moment of glory and strength before the scandal and horror of the Cross. As you lead your group through today's readings and discussions, remember that even when we don't fully understand, it is good that we are here with God. Understanding, courage, and all the rest will follow. Rest in his love.

**Featured study:** Was Jesus a real person or really God?

**Reflection:** The event recounted in this passage from Matthew takes place, scholars tell us, on the feast of Tabernacles in the Jewish festival calendar, which is both a harvest festival and a celebration of the giving of the Mosaic Law on Mount Sinai. Recognizing that fact helps us to see a little more deeply into this mysterious scene. When Moses went up to receive the Law, he took with him three Levites—Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu who would all serve in the priestly office in the Jewish liturgies. Jesus, likewise, takes three priestly figures with him up Mount Tabor—Peter, James, and John. Moses and these others "beheld God" on Sinai (Exodus 24:11) and Moses also beholds God now on Mount Tabor in the Person of Jesus Christ. Moses' presence on this other mountain makes clear to us that, not only is Jesus the same God seen on Sinai, but that he is also the new Law Giver, a new Moses in his humanity. The presence of Elijah the Prophet, who also encountered God on Mount Sinai (called Horeb), indicates that Jesus is the fulfillment of all prophecy and the ultimate prophet and the bearer of a new teaching, and so the voice of the Father insists that we must "listen to him." All these signs, the presence of these two figures from the Old Covenant, the bright cloud, and the divine voice, fill the three Apostles with awe. They now see, to fortify them in the trials of his coming Passion, the full glory of Christ's divine Sonship. St. John, who is the only one of the Gospel writers not to include this event, may have still have been in awe of it when, he says in the Prologue to his Gospel, "We have beheld his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father" (John 1:14).



## From the Pastor

### The Transfiguration of the Lord

What is Christianity finally about? These days if you ask almost anyone who doesn't know the Bible you'll probably hear an answer like this: "Being a good person" or "following the golden rule." No offense to the golden rule, but our faith is simply much stranger than that. This week's feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is a luminous example of this. Jesus becomes radiantly and overwhelmingly beautiful. The glory of God literally shines forth from his body and even his clothes. Here we see that Christianity is not mainly a moral system, but a relationship with God in Christ, one that finally makes human beings gloriously beautiful.

Now we can see our good and bad deeds in a new and de-centered way. Our morality isn't about a heaven or hell scorecard. It's about lives open (or closed) to transfiguration, lives capable of revealing the glory of God in Christ to the world. Spouses, children, friends, co-workers, priests, consecrated women and men, and so on — we are all called to let the beauty of Jesus make our lives beautiful, little by little. His beauty in us is the center of our faith.

# Vatican News

## 'Pope at Mass: Grandparents and young 'grow together' in fruitful exchange'

As the Church celebrated the 3rd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on Sunday, Pope Francis presided over Mass in St. Peter's Basilica for around 8,000 elderly people from across Italy. The theme for this year's iteration of the World Day is "His mercy is from age to age," recalling a passage from Luke's Gospel. In his homily at Mass, Pope Francis reflected on each of the three parables recounted in the day's Gospel reading, focusing on the common theme they share of "growing together".

Jesus' first parable in the Gospel passage, said the Pope, notes that wheat and weeds grow next to one another in the same field, which therefore reminds Christians to be realistic in our outlook on life.

"In human history, as in each of our lives, there is a mixture of light and shadows, love and selfishness," he said. "Good and evil are even intertwined to the point of seeming inseparable." He said that such a realistic attitude pushes aside ideologies and helps us realize that evil dwells not only "outside" of ourselves, but must also be confronted within ourselves.

The Pope went on to say that Christians should not seek to uproot the weeds of evil and thereby pull up the good wheat through an "impulsive and aggressive" attitude.

The correct attitude in the face of evil, said the Pope, is patience, which leads us to treat others with respect, and the awareness that "the definitive victory over evil is essentially God's work."

## OCIA Adult Faith Formation

Adult faith formation, OCIA, is calling for catechumens, candidates, and, the Curious Catholic. Who are these? Catechumens are unbaptized persons who desire to be fully incorporated into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Eucharist. Candidates, on the other hand, are those who are already Christians by baptism and are seeking full communion with the Catholic Church. These include Catholics who have been baptized but have not had the other Sacraments of Initiation, as well as Christians of other denominations who have had a valid baptism. Curious Catholics are all of us to one extent or another who wish to nurture and nourish our faith through improved understanding of all our Faith has to offer us drawing us closer to Jesus. The OCIA sessions are ideal for that. We will be meeting every Sunday morning with sessions starting after the 8:00am Mass usually concluding in time to attend the 10:00am Mass.

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

### Bautizos:

### Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

### Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

### First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

### Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

### Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.
