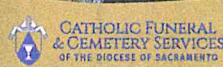

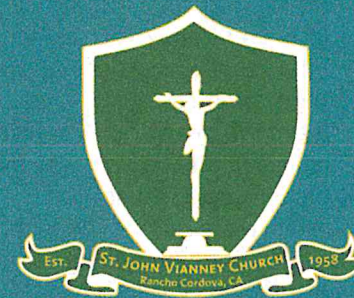

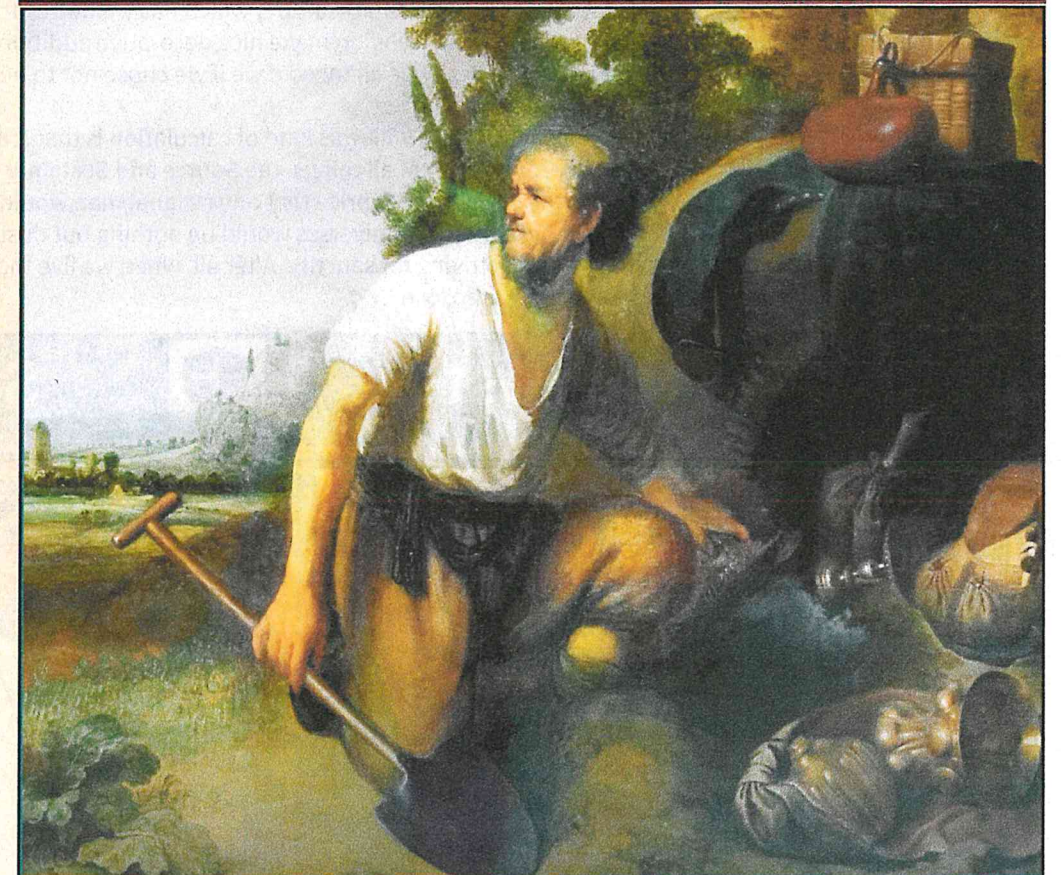

Review: The Bible often challenges us to compare the good we find in the world with the good we find in God. Today's Scriptures focus on comparing God's Word, law, commands, and will with earthly goods and riches. Psalm 119 tells us that while gold and silver are valuable, God's wisdom is even more valuable. The relative good of precious metals pales in comparison with the good to be found in God. The Gospel reading also asks us to make a comparison between the wealth of the world and the wealth of faith. Jesus says that the kingdom of heaven is more valuable than anything in this world. Like the merchant searching for fine pearls or the man seeking a treasure buried in a field, we must be willing to give up all that we have in order to gain Heaven. The fact is that the acquisition of Heaven comes at an incredible cost. If we are going to follow the Lord, we have to desire him more than anything the world offers: more than power, prestige, or wealth. If we are going to pursue God's way of wisdom, we must place everything in this world below our desire for to become saints. This leads us to the fundamental questions of life: What have you and I given up to become a follower of Christ? What are you and I willing to give up?

Featured study: Maximilian saint of Auschwitz

Reflection: The Danish religious philosopher Soren Kierkegaard, in a book called Purity of Heart Is to Will One Thing, strives to convince us to reject spiritual mediocrity. We tend to want to make a deal with God. "If you don't trouble me too much, I will confess faith in you and worship you ... on Sunday, that is." Our modern culture, which has yielded untold numbers of conveniences and technologies, only reinforces our sense that God and his religion make nice decorative additions to a life that is largely of our own choosing and making. For many of us, what would really be changed if we if we chose not to be Christians, but rather ethical pagans?

Jesus's short parables, however, reveal that the problem with this kind of calculation is that it attempts to weigh finite things against something of infinite weight. God is the very foundation of all things, the Source and Sustainer of the whole material universe and spiritual realm. He is the ultimate treasure, the pearl of great price that any rational man would sell everything to obtain. Even the whole universe cannot outweigh him in fact, innumerable universes would be nothing but dust in comparison. Every ounce of our energy ought to be expended in seeking him and striving for sanctity. After all, when we live that way, God supplies all the rest, or as St. Paul put it, "All things work for good for those who love God."

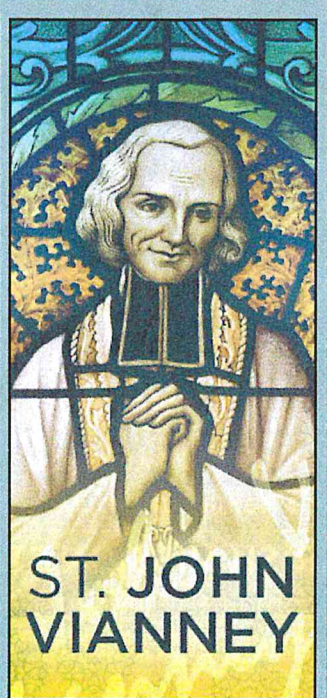

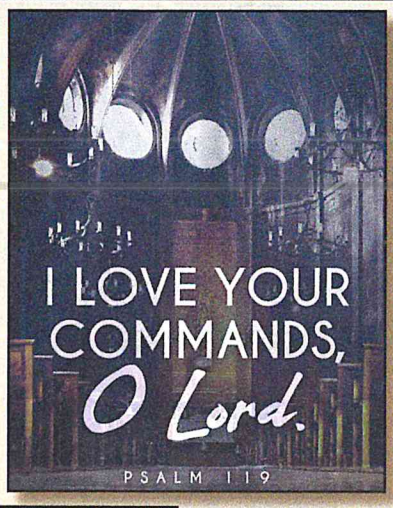

'Pope exhorts young people to "intensively" live the upcoming World Youth Day'

"Like Mary, you have risen, you have left behind what you know – your families, your comforts – and set out in haste to meet others." With these words, Pope Francis greeted a group of young people from Córdoba, Argentina, headed to Portugal for the upcoming World Youth Day, which will take place in Lisbon from August 1 to August 6.

The Pope compared the event to a very special "World Cup," a friendly match "where there are no winners or losers, but we all win." He highlighted how "when we step out of ourselves and meet others," giving what we have and being open to receive what others offer, "we are all winners and we can raise together the 'cup of brotherhood.'"

Pope Francis exhorted the young people to look at the footsteps of many Christians who followed Jesus to the end.

"This teaches us that with Christ's team, the game is on until the last minute. We cannot get distracted. We must be alert and play as a team."

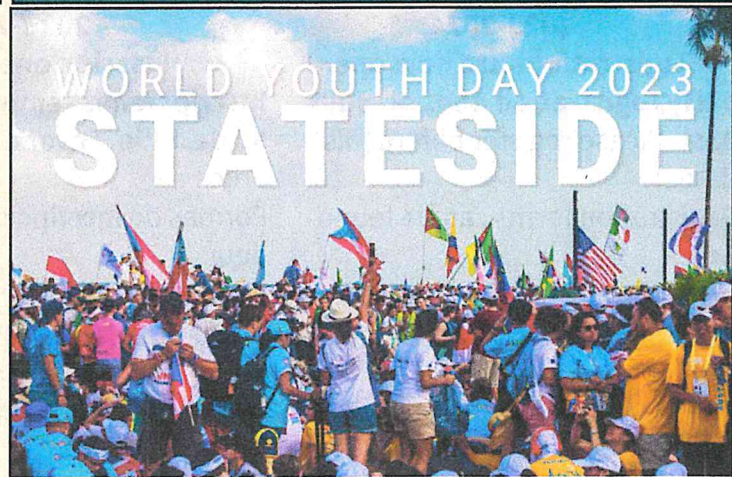
The Pope encouraged the group to "intensively" live the World Youth Day: an occasion to be enriched through "a great diversity of faces, cultures, experiences, different expressions and manifestations of our faith."

"Above all," Pope Francis added, "you will be able to ultimately experience the yearning of Jesus: that we are 'one' so that the world may believe."

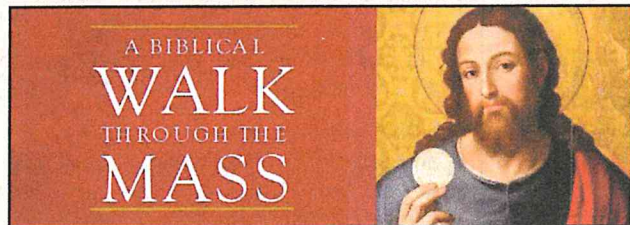

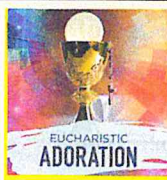

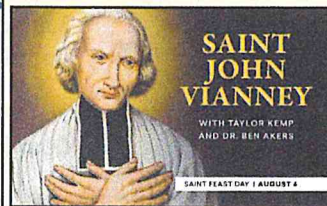

Join the New Adult Bible Study: Paul, A New Covenant Jew

Starts Aug 4, on the 1st and 3rd Friday of each month, in the Fr. Moroney room from 6-8 pm

Grace, justification, and works of the Law centering on the Dead Sea Scrolls (DSS), Romans, and Galatians, and will blow you away. The two books we are using for the next 24 months are from Vatican-recognized scholars. Their books study the 1st Century Jew, St. Paul, and his cultic Jewish beliefs and how those beliefs shaped the Catholic Church. It is a two-year study that coincides with the largest academic movement within Protestant academic circles after they discovered the DSS supported Catholic interpretations, not Martin Luther. These new revelations have not yet been preached down to the pews because of the dilemmas that non-Catholic Christian faiths will have to address because of the DSS. The beauty of this course is that it will give you an incredible confidence in the truth of the Church that Christ founded. Enjoy the lively debates and recognize that we are going to teach you how to fish instead of just giving you a fish to eat. Why, because Jesus told us to feed others.

Anointing of the Sick:

By appointment.

Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Confirmación para Jóvenes:

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.

OCIA and Adult Sacramental:
