Review: When we hear the parable of the Sower and seed, it can be easy to assume it is meant for someone else. After all, we are good soil, right? This week we are challenged to look a bit more deeply at our own lives and assess just what kind of soil we really are. All too often, many things like sin, busyness, worry, work, and other activities keep us from receiving fully the teachings of Christ. Our initial excitement and enthusiasm for the Gospel can give way to a sort of dull acceptance. The good seed that was sown in our lives can begin to wither and die. The soil of our lives isn't all that good. But it doesn't have to be that way. God, the Divine Sower, is always willing to sow new seeds in our lives. However, just as a lot of work goes into preparing-and tending-the soil of an actual garden, so too we have to make sure that the soil of our souls is prepared and cared for so that we can be in the right frame of mind and heart to receive the Word of God in new and deeper ways, now and for the rest of our lives.

Featured study: Shameless: Seeing yourself as God sees you.

Reflection: This parable from Matthew's Gospel and its explanation is often misunderstood. To some it sounds as though Jesus is saying that he specifically intends that some of his hearers will fail to understand him and so miss the salvation he brings! That, of course, is not what this Gospel means. (Recall that God "desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth," 1 Timothy 2:4; RSV: 2CE) The key to unlocking the meaning of Jesus's words is to recognize how parables function. "Why do you speak to them in parables?" the disciples ask. Jesus responds, "Because knowledge of the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven has been granted to you, but to them it has not been granted." While that last phrase, "to them it has not been granted," might suggest that God has withheld something that makes understanding the parable possible, in fact-and this is made clear in the parable of the Sower he tells -the reception of the meaning of the parable depends upon our free decision to be cultivated by God's grace. The good soil (we could say the good soul) that receives the seed (which is the word of the parable itself) is willing to be tilled by God's grace. That is why Jesus says, "To anyone who has {in other words, anyone who has freely received God's grace} more will be given." But Jesus also warns that "from anyone who has not {that is, has refused to receive God's grace} even what he has will be taken away." We are given the choice: either to become "good soil" and receive the riches of grace, or to reject God's Word.

'Pope establishes 'Commission for New Martyrs - Witnesses of the Faith'

Pope Francis released a letter on Wednesday, 5 July, in which he announced the establishment of the Dicastery for the Causes of Saints' "Commission for the New Martyrs - Witnesses of the Faith", in view of the Jubilee of 2025. The working group's objective will be to draw up a catalogue of all Christians who have shed their blood to confess Christ and bear witness to the Gospel.

"Martyrs in the Church," wrote the Pope, "are witnesses of the hope that comes from faith in Christ and incites to true charity. Hope keeps alive the profound conviction that good is stronger than evil, because God in Christ has conquered sin and death." The Commission will continue the search to identify the Witnesses of the Faith in this first quarter of the century and to continue in the future. This work was started during the Jubilee Year of 2000.

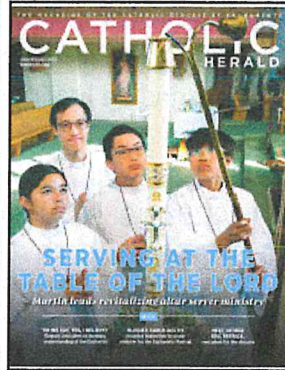
"Martyrs," the Pope continued, "have accompanied the life of the Church in every age and flourish as 'ripe and excellent fruits of the vineyard of the Lord' even today... Martyrs are more numerous in our time than in the first centuries: they are bishops, priests, consecrated men and women, lay people and families, who in the different countries of the world, with the gift of their lives, have offered the supreme proof of charity."

Hour of Adoration July 27th, 2023

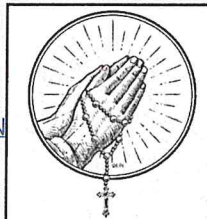

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Incripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Confirmación para Jóvenes:

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.

OCIA and Adult Sacramental:

For adults seeking one or more Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, or Confirmation). Sessions begin in the fall. Please contact the parish office for more information.

OCIA y Sacramentos para adultos:

Para adultos que buscan uno o más Sacramentos de Iniciación (Bautizo, Primera Comunión y Confirmación). Clases comienzan en el otoño. Favor de contactar la oficina parroquial.
