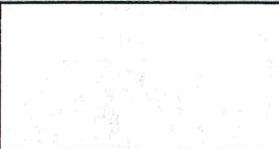

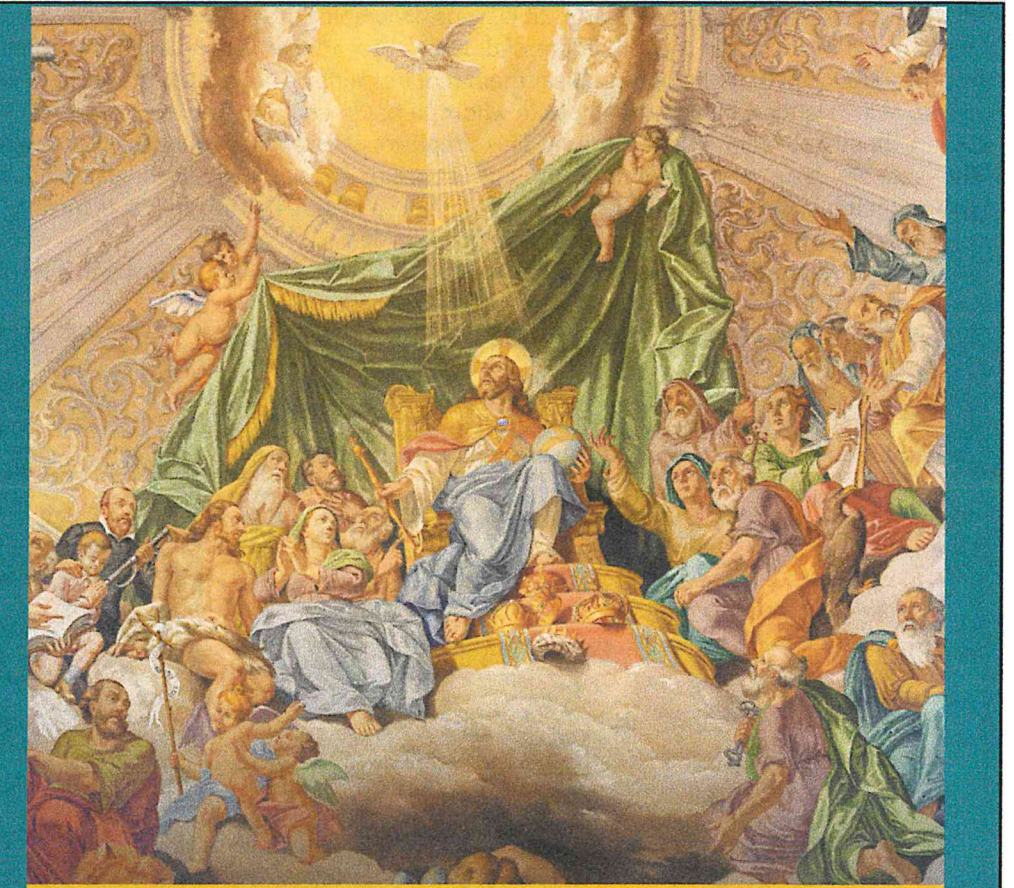

Review: This week we read three of Jesus's most famous parables: the Sower and the seed, the mustard seed, and the yeast in the three measures of flour. What do all of these have in common? The theme of patience. The farmer who sows the seed has to wait until both the wheat and the weeds mature before he can begin to sort them out. The mustard seed, which is miniscule, eventually becomes a huge bush. But patience is required for the seed to take root and reach maturity. Finally, the woman who kneads the yeast into the flour has to wait for the bread to rise before she can bake it. In all three cases, it's necessary to wait until you see the final result. You may know that there will be a crop of wheat, a large bush, and loaves of bread, but it takes time and patient waiting before you can see them. The same is often true with our desire to share the Faith. We want people to embrace the Gospel right away; we want an immediate, enthusiastic response to the Good News of salvation. It didn't work like that in the time of Jesus, and it doesn't today. Most of the time, we have to sow the seed or mix in the yeast-and then sit back and wait. No matter how much we might want to rush things, we need patience as we wait for faith to develop ... from tiny seeds and grains of yeast.

Featured study: The Eighth Rule: Spiritual Desolation & Patience

Reflection: In this Gospel passage we find corroboration of what we saw in the readings from previous Sundays, also from Matthew's Gospel. At verse 34 of Matthew 13 we read, "He spoke to them only in parables." The parables that Jesus tells function almost like medical heart monitors. When told, they register our state of heart, based upon how we respond to them. The weeds and the wheat, the mustard seed, the yeast that leavens the whole batch of dough ... these are figures that represent the mysteries of the Kingdom to those to whom they are addressed. To be able to "hear" them for what they tell us, we must have hearts that are open to the proclamation of that Kingdom. To hear them requires that we be open to the grace to do so. And how do we gain this grace, the grace to hear? Matthew tells us that those to whom "it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom" (Matthew 13:11; RSV: 2CE) are those who "went into the house." This simple locution speaks volumes. At the beginning of chapter 13 Matthew reports, "The same day Jesus went out of the house and sat beside the sea." He tells the parables that follow outside of this house and he explains their meaning inside the same house. The house of Jesus is the Church. If, having heard the proclamation of the Kingdom, we wish to know its secrets, we must enter the house of Jesus.

Jesus is both the Word spoken in the world and the very interpretation of that Word. But to hear it fully, we must go and abide with him where he will reveal to little ones the secrets of his Kingdom.

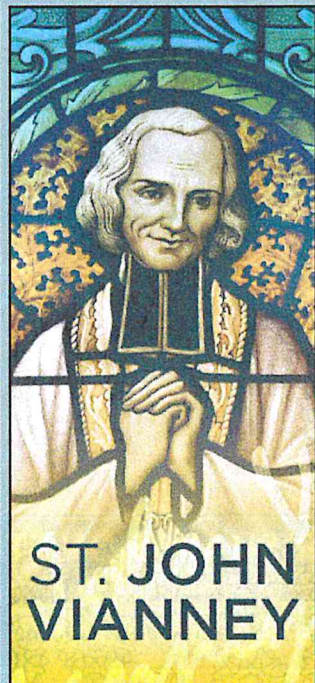

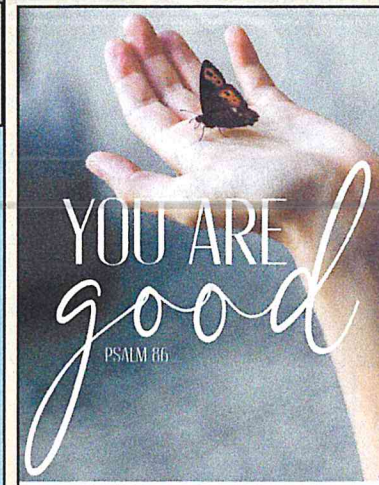

'Pope at Angelus: Only the little ones know how to welcome God's love'

Greeting pilgrims gathered in St. Peter's Square for the Sunday Angelus, Pope Francis invited everyone to reflect on the prayer Jesus addresses to the Father in today's Gospel, thanking the Lord for revealing all His works to "the little ones" who know how to welcome them (Mt 11:25). He also called on all faithful to ask themselves whether they marvel, like children, at God's works around us, or if we just let them pass by.

Just before Jesus' prayer, the Pope said, the Lord had recalled some of His works: "the blind receive their sight [...] lepers are cleansed, [...] the poor have the good news preached to them" (Mt 11:5), and "revealed what this means, saying that these are the signs that God is at work in the world."

The Gospel's message is therefore clear, said the Pope: "God reveals Himself by liberating and healing the human person, with a gratuitous love that saves."

"Jesus thanks His Father, because His greatness consists in His love and He never works outside of love."

However, he explained, the greatness of God's love and works is not understood by those "who presume to be great and who fabricate a god in their own image – powerful, inflexible, vindictive."

"Those who are full of themselves, proud, concerned only about their own interests, convinced they do not need anyone, are not able to accept God as Father," said the Pope.

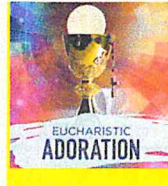

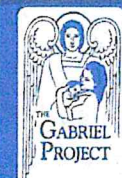

OCIA Adult Faith Formation

Adult faith formation, OCIA, the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults, is the process through which adults are received into full communion with the Church. All catechumens, candidates, and the Curious Catholic are invited to come and see.

Who are these?

Catechumens are unbaptized persons who desire to be fully incorporated into the Catholic Church through the Sacraments of Initiation. These sacraments are Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. Often, they are learning for the first time many of the elements of the Christian faith.

Candidates, on the other hand, are those who are already Christians by baptism and are seeking full communion with the Catholic Church. This includes Catholics who have been baptized but have not had the other Sacraments of Initiation, namely Confirmation and the Eucharist.

Curious Catholics are all of us who love our Faith and wants to nurture it further.

We will be meeting every Sunday morning with sessions starting August 27 after the 8:00am Mass usually concluding in time to attend the 10:00am Mass.

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunión:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

Confirmación para Jóvenes:

Candidatos para Confirmación deben de tener los 12 años cumplidos y cursar el séptimo grado. El programa es de dos años de educación religiosa antes de recibir el Sacramento.

OCIA and Adult Sacramental:

For adults seeking one or more Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, or Confirmation). Sessions begin in the fall. Please contact the parish office for more information.

OCIA y Sacramentos para adultos:

Para adultos que buscan uno o más Sacramentos de Iniciación (Bautizo, Primera Comunión y Confirmación). Clases comienzan en el otoño. Favor de contactar la oficina parroquial.
