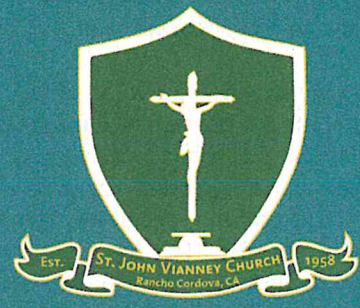

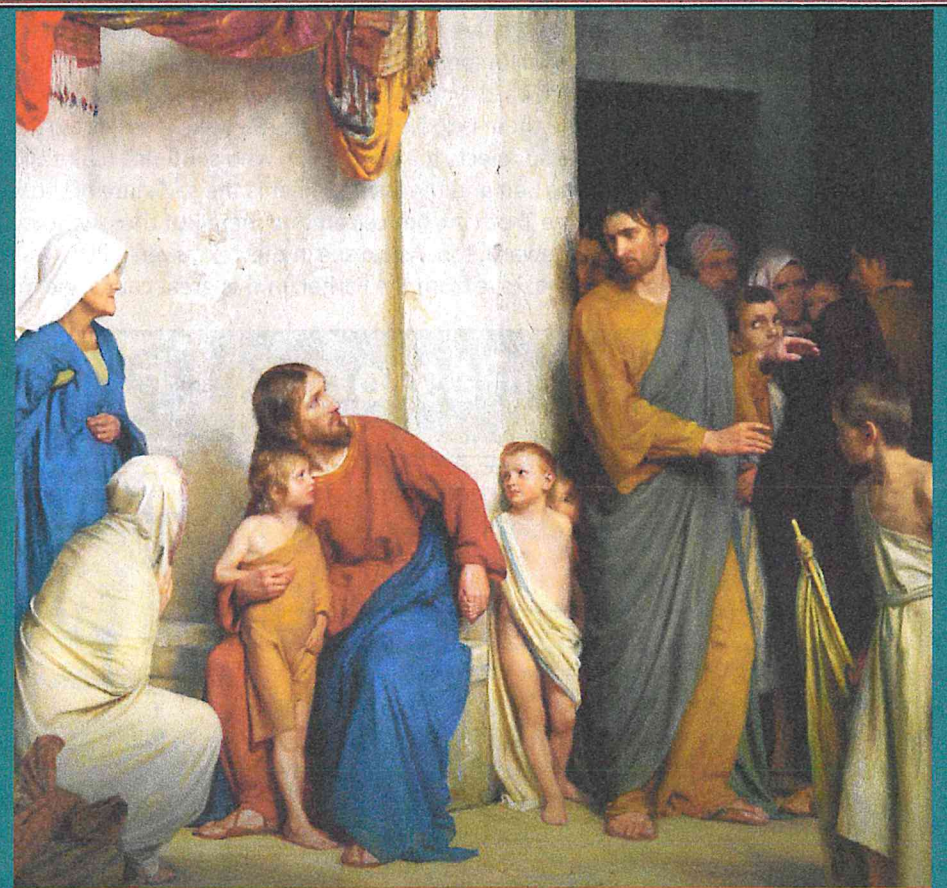

July 2nd 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Finding our Lives — Formed.org.

**Review:** If you ask people what they want, they'll often say that they want a new car, a better job, a bigger house, or some other possession. But if you probe a little deeper, you'll find that they don't really want possessions. Rather, they desire a sense of fulfillment, a feeling of being loved and cherished.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that "Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." In other words, the only way we can become truly happy and fulfilled is by giving ourselves in love to God and the people he has placed in our lives. We have to go beyond ourselves and our own selfish interests if we are to live the truly abundant life Jesus has promised. As Pope St. John Paul II often emphasized, "Man finds himself only by making a sincere gift of himself to others." It isn't always an easy choice, but it is the only way to a truly rewarding life. This week, in addition to the great lesson on the importance of self-giving love, Jesus also tells us, "Whoever receives you receives me, and whoever receives me receives the one who sent me." This has profound implications in today's world, where so many claim to be "spiritual but not religious." By this statement, Jesus explains that he has invested his authority in his Apostles. That same authority has been handed on over the centuries to the bishops and priests with the result that if we want to accept Jesus in our lives, we must accept the teachings of Jesus's successors and the Church in which they serve. In other words, to be "spiritual," we must also be "religious".

**Featured study:** Peter: keeper of the Keys

**Reflection:** In this Gospel reading we see once again the mystery of the unity of all the holy ones in Christ. As noted last week, in chapter 10 of Matthew Jesus is bestowing a share in his own authority upon the Apostles as they are sent out. They are warned that the preaching of the truth will evoke a division between those who accept the truth and those who won't. He promises to those who aid them in their mission a share in the reward of the missionary. And that is because those whom Christ sends bear him mysteriously within themselves such that to welcome them is to welcome him. St. Luke gives us a parallel text, "He who hears you hears me, and he who rejects you rejects me, and he who rejects me rejects him who sent me" (Luke 10:16).

To reject the Apostle is to reject both the Son and the Father! That is the sad state of those who refuse the truth and end up on the wrong side of the division that the Divine Truth introduces among men. But those who hear the truth and aid those who preach it, in even the smallest ways, will have their reward, too. As we see in this text, even a little water is a great gift when the cause for which it is given is that of the Son's own mission of love from the Father. In this great cause, we must value nothing more than that cause itself.



## From the Pastor



### For The Love of Jesus: A Reflection

Maybe you're familiar with the game Chutes and Ladders. The players roll dice to move from the start to the finish, from the bottom of the board to the top. If you land on a chute, you slide back and down. Land on a ladder, and you jump well up the board and near the goal. It was a thrill to find a ladder and draw closer to the goal. That's life, isn't it? At every moment, we're either moving closer or farther from the goal of our lives. How do we win? Jesus tells us the secret of life's chutes and ladders hinges on getting our loves rightly ordered. What we love in life is meant to be a ladder, drawing us up into God's love — including our family, friends, work, play, food, and drink. Even to give your water to someone out of love for Christ leads to a sure reward.

But those ladders of our loves can become chutes. If we love even our family members more than Christ, we slide down and back. If we love the persons and things in our life for the sake of Christ, He says we "surely will not lose our reward." The key difference between a chute and ladder, between our spiritual regression and advancement, is our willingness to renounce everything — even our own life — for the love of Jesus. To allow everything and everyone we love to draw us to love him more — that's the difference between chutes and ladders.

# Vatican News

Issued By The Eucharistic Revival Team, Vatican City, June 19, 2023

## '2024 National Eucharistic Congress and Monstrance Receive Special Papal Blessing'

On June 19, 2023, the Holy Father extended his Apostolic Blessing on the 10th National Eucharistic Congress and the monstrance that will carry Jesus in the Eucharist into Lucas Oil Stadium as the four National Eucharistic Pilgrimage routes converge in Indianapolis on July 16, 2024, the day before the five-day Congress opens next summer. The Mexican-made 4-foot monstrance, similar in construction to one used in a Los Angeles Eucharistic procession recently, is an homage to Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the National Eucharistic Revival. During the audience, Pope Francis welcomed and expressed his gratitude towards the team for their work in promoting "a revival of faith in, and love for, the Holy Eucharist." He shared further words of encouragement in anticipation of the first National Eucharistic Congress in the U.S. in over eighty years: "The National Eucharistic Congress marks a significant moment in the life of the Church in the United States." The pope affirmed the critical need for an increase of faith among Catholics in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, celebrated at every Mass and also through Eucharistic adoration—a devotion the Holy Father believes has been "lost" and which "we must rediscover."

"It is my hope, then, that the Eucharistic Congress will inspire Catholics throughout the country to discover anew the sense of wonder and awe at the Lord's great gift of himself and to spend time with him in the celebration of the Holy Mass and in personal prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament."

### Anointing of the Sick:

By appointment.

### Unción de los Enfermos:

### Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

### Bautizos:

Bautizos en Español son cada 3er Sábado del mes a las 9:30 am. Clases pre-bautismales son el Domingo anterior al bautizo de las 9am-1pm.

### Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

### Matrimonio:

Se requiere que las parejas contacten a la oficina parroquial cuando menos seis meses antes de la fecha de matrimonio. Clases prematrimoniales son en persona.

### First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.
