

**Review:** We have all been in need of something at some time— whether we needed to ask for a favor from someone or had an urgent need that had to be met. When it comes to asking God for things, what do we ask of him? Do we seek comfort, health, wealth, job security, or some other goal? Or, do we seek virtues like patience, humility, compassion, meekness, and so on? Let us turn to God and ask him to grant us the spiritual gifts we need, as we cooperate with his grace and learn to turn to him in all our human struggles.

#### Featured study: A school of prayer. Pope Benedict.

**Reflection:** This This week's Gospel contrasts sharply with the miracles of faith from Jairus and the hemorrhaging woman we read about last Sunday. These people have known Jesus all his life, and the fact that they are surprised by Jesus's deeds testifies to his humility. Though God, he remained for years an undistinguished member of his community. Only when the Father's plan ordained it did he begin to work miracles. But this does not win over his neighbors from Nazareth. Because of their familiarity with Jesus, they are irritated when he begins to show his mighty power.

This Gospel is warning for all. When it comes to faith, especially for lifelong Christians, it is possible to think that we have Jesus all figured out. When this happens, we become upset when he diverges from our expectations. This might be when he asks for faith during a major change in our lives, or when something small occurs and throws off our daily routine. Whenever we experience disappointment or disillusionment, Jesus wants us to trust him. Our plans and our ideas about how God should act must not be the object of our trust. To avoid this pitfall, it can be wise to spend some time examining what our idea of Jesus is, and to pray to know him as he truly is. And as always, the one who can help us best to appreciate Jesus is his Mother.



## **From the Pastor**

I think that we all have experienced some fear when we have been blindfolded, even when we know the place where we are at. That fear might paralyze us to move forward if we didn't know that there is someone next to us, someone whom we know and in whom we can trust to guide us. We Catholics know that that someone accompanying us through this temporal life toward eternal life is our Lord Jesus Christ, the rock that never fails.

This journey, on which we are about to embark, is somehow new to us all, in the sense that this is my first assignment as Pastor after working as Parochial Vicar for 8 years (6 years and a half working in the US with both the English and Spanish communities, first in Pennsylvania and then in Indiana), and that you will be getting to know and work with Franciscans of Mary Priests, religious Priests dedicated to spread the spirituality of gratitude.

As your new Pastor, I ask you to begin this journey by fixing our eyes with total confidence in Jesus the Son of God, our hope, so that nothing, no-one, and no evil spirit may disturb our hearts from following Him.

As for Fr. Brandon, from Mexico, he's still in his process to perfect his English. I would highly appreciate your patience and compassion. He is working hard to serve the Lord and his people the best way possible.



## Pope Francis: Jesus in the Eucharist strengthens us in times of trial

Jesus does not spare us from difficulties but strengthens us with the Eucharist to have the courage to face them, Pope Francis said in his reflection on Sunday's Gospel... "When a storm arrives, do I let myself be overwhelmed by the turmoil or do I cling to him ... to find calm and peace, in prayer, silence, listening to the Word, adoration, and fraternal sharing of faith?" the pope asked. Pope Francis urged people to remember that Jesus is always with us to come to our aid, particularly in the Eucharist. "In the Eucharist, he gathers us around him, he gives us his word, he nourishes with his body and his blood, and then he invites us to set sail, to transmit everything we have heard and to share what we have received with everyone, in everyday life, even when it is difficult," the pope said. "Jesus does not spare us contrarieties but, without ever abandoning us, he helps us face them," Francis added. "So we too, overcoming them with his help, learn more and more to hold onto him, to trust in his power, which goes far beyond our capacities, to overcome uncertainties and hesitations, closures and preconceptions, and to do this with courage and greatness of heart, to tell everyone that the kingdom of heaven is present, it is here, and that with Jesus at our side we can make it grow together, beyond all barriers."
