

#### June 11 The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ – Take and Eat — Formed.org.

Review: When we receive Holy Communion, we hear the words, "This is my Body" and "This is my Blood," to which we dutifully answer, "Amen." But have you ever considered exactly what those words mean? Today's Gospel asks us to examine Jesus's statement in a new way, because when we really look at them, his words are as shocking now as they were two thousand years ago. Jesus is telling us to eat his flesh and drink his blood! Little wonder people thought he was suggesting cannibalism when they first heard this teaching. As Catholics we receive the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ each time we receive the Eucharist. But do we really believe that? It's a question worth examining because in the Mass, Jesus is truly made present under the appearance of bread and wine. Each time we attend Mass, we celebrate the fact our God loves us so much that he nourishes us with himself so that we can become saints. It is both the greatest gift-and greatest mystery-of our faith. Ultimately, it is also the principal reason to be a Catholic-in order to receive the Lord in Holy Communion, just as he commanded the Jews of his day, and invites us to do today.

Featured study: The Eucharist by Dr. Scott Hahn

Reflection: The Church usually pairs the first Old Testament reading and the Gospel reading so that we can see that Jesus is the fullness of revelation and the summation and completion of the divine plan. But this habit of pairing Old Testament and New Testament texts to show their interrelation and to cast light on the mystery of Christ and his Church is not something made up by the Church. Rather, it is something she inherits from Christ and the Evangelists who recorded the words and acts of his ministry. When Christ says of his own Body and Blood, "This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever," he is making a clear association between the manna of the Exodus, which fed the natural hunger of the Hebrews in their desert journey, and the new manna from Heaven, which he will give to feed our deepest hunger. And just as the Exodus manna was real food, so too is the bread he will give: "For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink." And this real sharing of his Body and Blood will yield just the sort of koinonia that St. Paul mentions in our Second Reading: "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." The Eucharist is thus the sacrament that binds the Church together into Christ's Body.



### From the Pastor



#### Food For Thought: The Priesthood and the Eucharist

"These two Sacraments were born together," wrote St. John Paul II of the priesthood and the Eucharist, "and their destiny is indissolubly linked until the end of the world." The Eucharist is such a beautiful example of how God, conscious of our

limitations, bends to meet us. He once came to us cloaked in the flesh, that we might recognize Him. Now He comes as the very means by which we nourish ourselves: food and drink, the most familiar and comforting thing in the world to us. How easy He makes it to fulfill his command that we become one with Him. How generous He is to make such a sacred thing also accessible.

We can say the same of the priesthood, and of the men He calls to its number. How generous of Him to make such an accessible thing — our sons, our brothers, our uncles, our cousins sacred. How generous of Him to allow these human creations – who share in our own faults — to be the means through which He comes to us in the Eucharist.

Without the Eucharist, we would have no eternal life. Without priests, we would have no Eucharist. On this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let's give thanks for our priests, and redouble our prayers that God will send us good and holy ones — manna from Heaven in our wandering exile.



# 'Pope Francis gives support to launch of Family Global

Pope Francis has expressed his support for the Family Global Compact that is being launched as a way to support the welfare of the family, "decisive for the future of the world and that of the Church." In a message released on Tuesday 30 May, the Pope lauded the goals of the Compact, an initiative of the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life and the Pontifical Academy for Social

The Family Global Compact aims to bring the pastoral care of families into dialogue with centres of study and research on the family located in Catholic universities around the world, especially in view of the new challenges families face today. The goal is also mutually beneficial, the Pope writes in his message, "to enable the pastoral care of families in the particular Churches to benefit from the research and the educational and training programmes in Catholic universities."

The Pope notes how by uniting together universities and programmes of pastoral ministry, both can better promote a culture of family and life in these times of uncertainty and worry. The hope is to assure people today and new generations can greater appreciate the beauty, value, and essential importance of marriage and family life, and generating and nurturing human life. Citing his Apostolic Exhortation Amoris Laetitia, the Pope sums up the goal: to make "a more responsible and generous effort to present the... motivations for choosing marriage and the family and in this way, to help men and women better respond to the grace that God offers them. 


