

Review: In our reading from Exodus, Moses has an incredible encounter with God. Moses didn't want an abstract knowledge of God, but wanted to know the Person of God, to see the face of God, to learn God's name. In response, God reveals his innermost name. Why is this so important? When we know a person's name, we can enter into a relationship with them. So when Moses learns God's name, he begins to learn God's character as well. Moses talks about God's rich, steadfast love, and those characteristics become a kind of mission statement: "The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity." In fact, this "mission statement" from Exodus 34 is the most quoted line of the Pentateuch. Throughout their history, the Israelites have held onto God's mercy and from that identity comes God's deeds-his mercy, his kindness, and his steadfast love. Then in the Gospel of John, we get the famous line about God so loving the world, that he gave his only Son. This highlights two of the key actions of God: first his love, and second, his giving. Through this we learn that love is an action, not a feeling, and that love is expressed in giving. From all of this we come to realize that God is a loving God who wants to share his goodness with us, so he gives us the Son, who infinitely gives himself back to the Father. This love and mutual self-giving is the Person of the Holy Spirit, for God is love and his deeds are love. God is one God, with Three Persons united in love, and the Holy Spirit is the manifestation of that giving love.

Featured study: Wisdom & Works for Mercy: Season 8: Communion

Reflection: "God so loved the world ..." This is one of the best known phrases from the Bible. It's not at all uncommon to see "John 3:16" on placards at sporting events or even on roadside billboards. It has become emblematic of the whole Gospel of Jesus Christ because it tells us in brief about the whole of salvation history and the Father's plan for the human race. In Jesus, the Father's only Son, the Father announces not only his intent to save the world, but also his very divine identity as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In the Person of Christ, these two dimensions of the Gospel, redemption, and revelation, are intimately united. By revealing who he is, God simultaneously reveals his saving love. The God who loves us to the end as St. John will later say in Chapter 13 in his Gospel reveals the depth of that love first in his self-revelation to us that he is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Out of the immense fire of love that God is in himself-the eternal exchange of love between the three divine Persons-comes the saving love of Christ's Incarnation. The pierced side of our Savior on the Cross pierces our hearts to reveal the essence of Trinitarian love. The immensity of the divine love, in both its redeeming and revealing dimensions, fills us with the confidence that he comes not to condemn the world, but so that we "might not perish but have eternal life."





Vatican News

'Pope urges Italian Bishops' assembly to address challenges of Church and world'

The dialogue between Pope Francis and the Italian Bishops on Monday afternoon was frank and serene. On 22 May, the Holy Father met with over 200 bishops of the Italian Bishops' Conference (CEI), gathered for the 77th General Assembly at the

They spoke of young people and vocations, finances and ideologies, the ministry of priests and seminaries, peace, the environment and concern for charity, the latter of which the Pope expressed great appreciation for the Italian Church. The Pope opened the work of the bishops' spring meeting, which runs from Monday until 25 May in the Aula Nuova of the Synod, on the theme "Listening to what the Spirit is saying to the Churches: Steps towards discernment"....

Their conversation also focused on the ministry of priests, to whom, as always, the Pope asked the bishops to show closeness. There was no lack of reference to peace, in Ukraine and in the world, an urgency that concerns everyone, then to the ideologies of our time, then to the various cultural problems and the issue of finances, which often represent a difficulty for the Church. Also at the centre were environmental issues for which a change of mentality is needed. A 'new style' is also what is called for by the synodal path involving the Church of the five continents. Along with this came the invitation to pay attention to poverty, old and new, and above all to never let charity be lacking.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS MEMBERSHIP DRIVE





Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunion:

Programa de dos años en el programa de formación familiar es requerido. Los niños deben tener 6 años cumplidos o más. Inscripciones son Junio-Agosto y las clases son Septiembre-Mayo.

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.
