Review: This Sunday we are presented with a Gospel reading that should deeply challenge us. These are readings that remind us of who we really are-disciples of Jesus Christ. We are not only his friends, called to stay near to him, but we are also his missionaries, called to go out and to spread his Good News. Not only are we sent out to share the Word, but Jesus says that we will even perform signs in his name. When we read words like this from Jesus, there's usually a small voice inside of us that says, "That was back then, but stuff like that doesn't happen now." But that voice is not from the Lord. In the scripture today, our Lord clearly calls us to have faith and says that those who believe in his name will be accompanied by miraculous signs. So we have to ask ourselves, what does it really mean to be a disciple of Jesus Christ? Does our Church today look like the lives of the early Christians who healed the sick, raised the dead, and cast out demons? Do we really believe that even though Jesus Christ ascended, he is alive in us and can work with us to proclaim the gospel?

Featured study: Evangelization with Chris Stefanick. If you want our parish to come alive again, then this might motivate you to start the study "Sacred Story Institute" by the Ignatius Institute, a small group study for 6-8 people, for 96 weeks.

Reflection: Mark's account of the Ascension corroborates Christ's statement: "It is good for you that I go away" (John 16:7). In true Markian style there is immediacy: Christ goes, and the disciples go forth and do what he has commanded. Notice that Pentecost is not even mentioned as a separate event. Yet it is clearly implied. The gospel begins with a command and promises. Recall how in the first reading Christ refers to the Holy Spirit as the "promise of my Father." And at the conclusion it stated that the LORD is still working with them and confirming them. It is interesting to note in this gospel reading what the promises imply. Christ gives his followers a job and the power to do it. He does not promise an easy time. In fact, they endure serpents, poisoned drinks, sick people, etc. But they are given (and so are we) the assurance of the ability to handle whatever the job entails. A tough and hugely important job and the power to see it through. One is reminded of Moses's commission described in the early chapters of Exodus. He is uncertain of his ability-it's a tall order to go to Pharaoh and take away all his slaves. And it's not like God is giving him an army; he's mostly asking him to fight with his words. Yet God gives him help as well, including miraculous power to handle serpents (see Exodus 4:3-4) and the assistance of Aaron his brother (see Exodus 3:10). For Christ's disciples the task is similar. Like Moses we are to go back to our brothers and set them free through proclamation of the Gospel, wresting them from the evil one. And for this task the power of the Holy Spirit is offered, and so is the companionship of Christ himself.

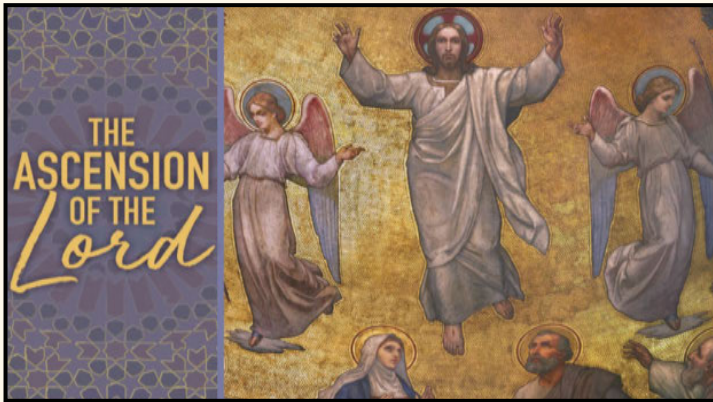

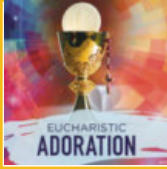

OCIA Adult Faith Formation

“Christianity is the only faith in which the evangelist converts those turning toward God; and in which those turning to God convert the evangelist.” - Reverend Timothy Keller

OCIA, formally known as RCIA, that is the Right of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process through which adults are received into full communion with the Church. We need those who wish to join our OCIA team and become a catechist.

What is a catechist? A catechist is a person of faith called to hand on the living tradition and teachings of the Catholic Church. A catechist has a mature understanding of our faith and a personal relationship with Jesus interested in sharing their faith. We meet on Sunday mornings and discuss a different topic each session.

This morning, we will be discussing evangelism. All of us catechists agree that no matter how many times we attend a session we always come away learning something new and enriched in our faith. To paraphrase the above quote

“Catholicism is the only faith in which the catechist converts the catechumen, and the catechumen converts the catechist.”

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held once a month on Sunday from 11:30am-2:30pm.

Bautizos:

Marriage:

Pope at Audience: Faith is first gift of Christian life

Without the three theological virtues, “we would not have eyes that see even in the dark, we would not have a heart that loves even when it is not loved, we would not have a hope that dares against all hope,” Pope Francis said at the General Audience on Wednesday.

After considering the four cardinal virtues, the Holy Father has now turned to the theological virtues, focusing this week on faith, “the act by which the human being freely commits himself to God.”

In his catechesis, the Holy Father held up the example of Abraham, who left his home for a new land at God’s command and was willing to sacrifice his son Isaac due to his trust in God. Moses, too, was a man of faith, continuing “to stand firm and trust in the Lord, and even defend the people who were so often lacking in faith.”

Pope Francis then pointed to the Blessed Virgin Mary, who responded to the Angel’s annunciation with the humble reply, “Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord.” “With her heart full of trust in God,” the Pope said, Mary set out on her path without knowing either the route or the dangers.

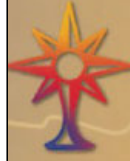
It is faith that “makes the Christian,” the Pope said, because “to be Christians is not first and foremost about accepting a culture,” but about a relationship with God.

...Faith, the Pope said, “is the happiest gift, the only virtue we are permitted to envy,” precisely because it “triggers’ grace in us and opens the mind to the mystery of God.”
