

May 14, 2023, Sixth Sunday of Easter—Formed.org.

Review: While our salvation was won by Jesus's Death, our lives in Christ are not completely fulfilled until we receive the Advocate, the Spirit of truth, that Jesus promised to send us. That Spirit of truth is the Third Person of the Trinity, the Holy Spirit. It is only through the Spirit that we are able to enter into the fullness of communion with the Father and the Son and embrace the Good News of the Gospel in our daily lives. Today's First Reading shows us how that works. Although Jesus himself had passed through Samaria, and even revealed himself as the Messiah to the woman at the well, it wasn't until after the Holy Spirit had come that the people in that region were able to fully accept Philip and his teachings about Jesus. Then, once they were able to accept Jesus through Baptism, Peter and John came, prayed, laid hands on the people, and the Holy Spirit descended upon them. This reading may shed some light on the important distinction between the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. Baptism brings us into the family of God, but Confirmation enables us to live out the Christian message with greater courage and conviction through the Holy Spirit. Moreover, Jesus says that not only is the Spirit with us, but he also actually remains within us. This is why Jesus tells us that "I am in my Father, and you are in me and I in you." Through the action of the Spirit, we are united in an unprecedented way with God and can truly become his sons and daughters.

Featured study: Saint Peter. A movie with Omar Sharif is fantastic.

Reflection: John begins his Gospel, "In the beginning was the Word," and the importance of words in his Gospel is partly derived from that foundational statement. As the Word, Jesus is the definitive law of God. In himself he expresses the new law, the new commandment, the new covenant of love. He makes clear in this passage that like the old covenant, one must obey the commandments of God as an act of love for God. For the Jews and for Jesus, love and law aren't opposed-they're vitally linked. This obedient love leads to "seeing" and "recognizing" in John. In the RSV edition, "recognize" is translated as "know," which better connotes of an active relationship between the knower and the one known. So obedient love, keeping the commandments, leads to a knowing" that's mysterious and, perhaps, comparable to the knowledge of marriage. The world cannot know the Son, Spirit, or Father in this way; rather, only the obedient disciple can be caught up in this embrace. In that embrace, love and law melt into one; just as the vows of marriage are at one and the same time a law under which the spouses place themselves and a word of love that they share.





Pope's May prayer intention: For ecclesial movements and groups'

Pope Francis is dedicating his May prayer intention to ecclesial movements and groups, which says are a "gift" and a "treasure" in the Church.

In his video-message, published each month by the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network, Pope Francis says, "These movements renew the Church with their capacity for dialogue at the service of her evangelizing mission." He notes, too, that each group has its own unique charism, which allows them to demonstrate both the beauty and the novelty of the Gospel proclamation.

Each charism is different, he explains, thanks to the creativity that marks the various groups and movements. Although they seem to be speaking different languages, by understanding themselves, they are able to make themselves understood.

At the same time, the Pope warns them to avoid the temptation of turning in on themselves, by inviting them to continue to work "at the service of the Bishops and the parishes."

Pope Francis encourages them to "always be on the move, responding to the impulse of the Holy Spirit to the challenges in today's world," while remaining "in harmony with the Church, since harmony is the gift of the Holy Spirit."

The Holy Father concludes his message with the prayer "that ecclesial movements and groups may daily rediscover their mission, an evangelizing mission, and that they place their own charisms at the service of the world's needs."



Baptisms:

English baptisms are held every 1st Saturday of the month at 9:30 am. Pre-baptismal classes are held online.

Bautizos:

Marriage:

As a minimum requirement, couples must contact the parish office and set an appointment at least 6 months prior to the wedding date. Marriage preparation classes online.

Matrimonio:

First Eucharist:

A two year family formation program preparation is required. Children must be a minimum of 6 years old. Classes run from September-May and registrations are open June-August.

Primera Comunion:

Youth Confirmation:

Candidates for Confirmation must be at least 12 years old and in 7th grade to start the program. A two-year religious education preparation is required prior to receiving the Sacrament.

RCIA and Adult Sacramental:

For adults seeking one or more Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Eucharist, or Confirmation). Sessions begin in the fall. Please contact the parish office for more information.
